Similarly, some of the proposed or programmed expenditures are not disaggregated or attributed to a specific revenue item since the law only provides that these expenditures be sourced from the collections of the agency. Meanwhile, expenditure columns for some agencies have not been provided with any amount because the DBM neither approved nor received any proposal from the agency.
