 In view of the two (2) failed public biddings, the Department of Budget and Management (DBM) Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) invites interested bidders to participate in the negotiation for the Supply of Petroleum, Oil, Lubricants, Various Motor Vehicle Supplies and General Servicing of All DBM Vehicles for CY 2012 in accordance with Section 53.1 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9184, otherwise known as the "Government Procurement Reform Act".

Interested bidders shall submit the following eligibility documents on January 20, 2012, 10:00 am: (i) SEC Registration Certificate; (ii) valid Mayor's Permit; (iii) statement of all ongoing and completed government and private contracts within two (2) years from the date of submission and receipt of bids which shall include a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC; (iv) audited financial statements for the preceding calendar year and stamped received by the Bureau of Internal Revenue; and (v) computation of Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) or a commitment from a Universal or Commercial Bank to extend a credit line in favor of the prospective bidder if awarded the contract to be bid;
