The appropriations herein provided for the construction, rehabilitation, replacement, completion, and repair of school buildings shall be directly released to, and administered by, the Department of Public Morks and Highways based on the work program submitted by the Department of Education, Culture and Sports: PROVIDED, That the initial release shall be made thirty (30) days after the approval of this Act in an amount equal to fifty percent (50%) of the appropriations herein provided, including its corresponding Motice of Cash Allocation. 2. Allocation of School Buildings. The allocation of school buildings herein funded shall be apportioned as follows: (1) thirty percent (30%) of the total capital outlay to be allocated pro-rata according to each legislative district's school age population in relation to the total school age population of the country; (2) sixty percent (60%) of total capital outlay to be allocated only among those legislative districts with classroom shortages, pro-rata to the total classroom shortage of the country as determined by the Department of Education, Culture and Sports; (3) ten percent (10%) to be allocated in accordance with the implementation of such policy as may be determined by the DECS: PROVIDED, That the allocation for Mationwide shall not be subject to the said apportionment: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That the same be made available for the construction of both elementary and secondary school buildings: PROVIDED, FURTHERMORE, That calamity stricken areas, particularly those areas affected by typhoons "Rosing" and "Pepang" and the Mount Parker explosion, shall be given priority in the implementation of the DECS-School Building Program. 3. Fabrication of Demountable School Buildings. The fabrication of demountable school buildings in accordance with the specifications and cost estimates of the Department of Public Morks and Highways shall be undertaken in the Region whenever the necessary technical capability is available: PROVIDED, That the allocation of demountable school building shall be made upon prior consultation with the Representative of the legislative district concerned. 4. Creation of Summer Jobs in the School Building Program. In the implementation of the School Building Program, the Department of Education, Culture and Sports shall create summer jobs for students and out-of-school youths: PROVIDED, HOWEVER, That such summer jobs shall not exceed two months. 5. Implementation of School Building Program. In the administration of the DECS-School Building Program in accordance with the provisions of R.A. 7880, the DPMH may authorize the DECS, the local government units and/or accredited non-government organizations to undertake project construction. For this purpose, appropriate Memorandum of Agreement and/or other forms of collaboration shall be entered into and between DPWH and the authorized implementing entity.
