Special Provisions

1. Augmentation of Items in the Appropriation of the Office of the Ombudsman. The Ombudsman is hereby authorized, subject to appropriate accounting and auditing rules and regulations, to augment items of appropriation in the Office of the Ombudsman from savings in other items of appropriation actually released, for: (a) printing and/or publication of decisions, resolutions, training and information materials; (b) repair, maintenance and improvement of OMB Central and Area/Sectoral facilities; (c) purchase of books, journals, periodicals and equipment; (d) payment of commutable representation and transportation allowances of officials and employees who by reason of their positions are entitled thereto and fringe benefits as may be authorized specifically by law for officials and personnel of OMB pursuant to Section 8 of Article IX-8 of the Constitution; and (e) for other official purposes subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

2. Funding for Transferred Functions. Such amount as may be necessary to finance or discharge the function in the conduct of investigation involving offenses of military personnel pursuant to Section 1 of R.A. No. 7055 dated June 20, 1991 shall be transferred to the Office of the Ombudsman.

3. Appropriations for Specific Programs and Activities. The amounts herein appropriated for the programs of the agency shall be used specifically for the following activities in the indicated amounts and conditions:
