Special Provision

1. Implementation of the SUCs-Computerization Program. The amount of Sixty Million Pesos (P60,000,000) shall be released to the Commission on Higher Education to support the computerization program of both private and state universities and colleges, including computer training of teachers taking into consideration future networking among schools, access to the internet and capability for electronic instruction. Private universities and colleges may draw from the fund: PROVIDED, That they shall put up a counterpart fund which shall be equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the cost of their program: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That the amount allocated shall not exceed twenty-five percent (25%) of this fund.

The Commission on Higher Education and the Philippine Association of State Universities and Colleges shall issue the guidelines for this purpose.
