The release of the appropriated amounts shall be made in accordance with the guidelines agreed upon between the Department of Foreign Affairs and the Department of Budget and Management.
- 2. Commitments to International Conferences. The amount herein authorized shall be used only for the hosting of international conferences duly approved by the President. The funds shall be directly released to the host agency.
- 3. Foreign Exchange Differential and Remittance Charges. The Department of Foreign Affairs shall be allowed to charge foreign exchange differentials and administrative charges attendant to the payment/remittance of international contributions against the International Commitments Fund.
