# Special Provisions

1. Land Surveys. The amount allotted for land surveys may be spent for subdivision surveys of settlement areas and private lands acquired by the Department, which may be undertaken by administration or by private land surveyors, subject to auditing rules and regulations and public bidding: PROVIDED, That in the updating and/or corrections of surveys in the land acquired by the defunct National Resettlement and Rehabilitation Administration (MARRA), the Land Tenure Administration (LTA) and the Land Registration personnel and resources.

2. Land Acquisition and Distribution. The amount allotted for land acquisition and distribution shall be used exclusively for the said purpose and shall not be used to augment other items of expenditures.

3. Positions of Undersecretaries and Assistant Secretaries. The positions of Undersecretaries and Assistant Secretaries herein provided in the staffing summary, which are limited to three (3) each respectively, are inclusive of those funded from the Agrarian Reform Fund.

4. Engineering and Administrative Overhead. To ensure that at least ninety six and one half percent (96.5%) of the amount released for farm-to-market roads is made available for direct implementation of the project, any authorized deductions to cover administrative overhead, preconstruction activities after detailed engineering, construction project management, testing, and quality control, acquisition, rehabilitation and repair of heavy equipment and other related equipment and parts used in the implementation of the project (3.5%).

5. Appropriations for Programs and Specific Activities. The amounts herein appropriated for the programs of the agency shall be used specifically for the following activities in the indicated amounts and conditions:
