### Special Provision(s)

The HRYCB shall submit to the DBM, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President of the Senate of the Philippines, the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance, either in printed form or by way of electronic document, quarterly reports on the status of the trust receipts. The Chairperson of the HRYCB and the Board's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said quarterly reports are likewise posted on the CHR website.

2. Trust Receipts for the Human Rights Violations Victims Memorial Commission. The amount of Three Hundred Sixteen Million Fifty Mine Thousand Eight Hundred Twenty Mine Pesos and Eighty Three Centavos (P316,059,829.83) as certified by the Bureau of Treasury on May 20, 2016 representing accrued interest on the Ten Billion Pesos (P10,000,000,000) fund of the HRVCB for the period 27 March 2014 to 31 March 2016, shall be used for the establishment, restoration, preservation and conservation of the memorial, museum, library and compendium in honor of the human rights violation victims during the Marcos regime in accordance with Section 27 of R.A. Ho. 10368. Said amount shall be deposited with the Mational Treasury and recorded as trust receipts in accordance with E.O. Mo. 338.

<sup>1.</sup> Trust Receipts for the Reparation of Human Rights Violations Victims. The amount of Ten Billion Pesos (P10,000,000,000) shall be used for payment of reparation of human rights violations victims and operating requirement of the Human Rights Victims Claims Board (HRYCB) sourced from the forfeited Marcos ill-gotten wealth in accordance with Section 7 of R.A. Mo. 10368. Said amount shall be deposited with the Mational Treasury and recorded as trust receipts in accordance with E.O. Mo. 338, s. 1996.

The Human Rights Violations Victims' Memorial Commission (HRVVNC) shall submit to the DBM, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President of the Senate of the Philippines, the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance, either in printed form or by way of electronic document, quarterly reports on the status of the trust receipts. The Chairperson of the HRVVNC and the Commission's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said quarterly reports are likewise posted onm the CHR website.

- 3. Release of Funds. The amount of Seven Hundred Twenty Four Million Eight Hundred Sixty Eight Thousand Pesos (P724,868,000) appropriated herein shall be automatically and regularly released pursuant to Section 6, Subtitle A, Title II, Book V of E.O. Mo. 292 and Supreme Court decision under G.R. Mo. 155336 dated July 21, 2006.
- 4. Appropriations for Programs and Specific Activities. The amounts appropriated herein for the programs of the agency shall bee used specifically for the following activities in the indicated amounts and conditions:
