- 4. Use of Multi-Year Obligational Authority (MYOA) for multi-year infrastructure projects.
- 5. Strictly impose calibrated sanctions / penalties on contractors with negative slippages.
- 6. Strictly enforce uniform guidelines on suspension and blacklisting contractors / suppliers / consulting firms.
- 7. Revisit level of authority of District Engineering Offices based on performance and absorptive capacity.
- 8. Integrate physical and financial accomplishment to existing DPWH system for an integrated real time reporting.
- 9. Expedite ROW resolution based on new ROW Law.
- 10. Streamline procurement process based on New Procurement Manual.
