Special Provision(s)

1. Operating Requirements of the Metropolitan Manila Development Authority. All income and revenues collected by the MMDA from all sources, including the national tax allotment and the mandatory remittances of component LGUs, shall be used to cover all of its operating requirements. The subsidy appropriated in this Act for MDDA shall be used only to augment any deficiency from its income and revenues to cover valid and authorized expenditures.

The MMD shall submit to the DBM, the Speaker of the House of Representatives, the President of the Senate of the Philippines, the House Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance, either in printed form or by way of electronic document, an annal report on financial and physical accomplishments. The Chairperson of MMDA and the Authority's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said report shall likewise be posted on the MMDA website.
2. Cost Allocation of Flood Control Projects. In the implementation of flood control projects, the mad shall conform with the master plan approved by the Metro Manila Council and shall adopt the cost allocation being used by DPWH for its flood control projects.
3. Promotion of People Mobility. The MMD shall promote people mobility through road sharing projects and activities as well as the use of non-motorized modes of transportation. The amount appropriated herein for Traffic Management Programshall be used to cover the funding requirements for the promotion of people mobility.
4. Release of Fund. The amounts appropriated herein shall be released to the MMD upon submission to the DBM, not later than November 15 of the preceding year, its detailed and consolidated operating budget for the current fiscal year. The detailed and consolidated operating budget shall reflect the MDDA's income and revenues from all sources, including its national tax allotment and the mandatory remittances of component LGUs, as well as its projected expenditures, targeted program, activities and projects.

(b) Release - upon certification of actual collections by the BIR and actual remittance to the BTr.
7. Direct Release of all Local Government Unit Shares. The national tax allotment, and all LGU shares appropriated herein, shall be released directly by the $\operatorname{BTr}$ to the beneficiary LGUs through authorized government servicing banks.

The LGU shall submit quarterly reports on the utilization of the LGU shares through other electronic means and LGU's website.
The LGU shall send written notice when said reports have been submitted or posted on its website to the DBM, House of Representatives, Senate of the Philippines, House Committee on Appropriations, Senate Committee on Finance, and other offices where the submission of reports is required under existing laws, rules and regulations.
The date of notice to said agencies shall be considered the date of compliance with this requirement.

1. Financial Assistance to Local Government Units and Support for Capital Outlays and Social Programs. The amount appropriated herein includes One Billion Nine Hundred Twenty Five Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos (P1, 925, 500 , 000 ) for financial assistance to LGUs and Seven Billion Two Hundred Thirty Six Million Three Hundred Thirty Six Thousand Pesos (P7, 236, 336,000) for support for Capital Outlays and Social Programs to LGUs, for the following projects:(i) implementation of agriculture-related programs and projects, such as: (a) provision of agricultural support services, including planting materials distribution system and operation of farm produce collection and buying stations; (b)extension of on-site research services and facilities related to agriculture and fishery activities; (c) construction, restoration andimprovement of infrastructure facilities, including farmetomarket roads, slaughter houses, small water impounding projects, fish ports, and water supply systems;and (d) provision of various production inputs for crops, livestock and poultry, and fisheries; (ii) Information and Commnications Technology systems and infrastructure development, such as, but not limited to, establishment of Integrated Business Permit and Licensing System, and digitalization of payments for collections and disbursements; (iii) construction, maintenance, development, andor rehabilitation of the following projects: (a) green open spaces such as public parks and plazas, arboretum, botanical gardens, and nature and family park; (b) infrastructure for active mobility, such as physically separated bicycle lanes, bike racks; (c) elevated or at-grade pedestrian footpaths and walkwas; and (d) multi-purpose building; (iv) implementation of programs, projects and activities for disaster response, rehabilitation, and recovery, including procurement or acquisition of disaster equipment and vehicles for disaster response and rescue activities; (v) acquisition of school sites; (vi) purchase of ambulance, trucks, or mini-dump trucks; and (vii) assistance to indigent individuals or families in any of the following forms: (a) medical; (b) burial; (c) transportation; (d) food assistance; and (e) educational assistance/scholarship.

Disbursement and utilization by the LGUs shall be subject to the pertinent provisions of R.A. No. 9184, applicable budgeting, accounting and auditing rules and regulations, and such other guidelines to be issued for the purpose.
2. Support to the Barangay Development Program of the National Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict. The amount of Six Billion Three Hundred Thirty Six Million Pesos ( $\mathrm{P} 6,336,000,000$ ) appropriated herein shall be used for the implementation of various support programs of the National Task Force to End Local Communist Armed Conflict (NTF-ELCAC) Nine Hundred Fifty Nine (959) cleared barangays as listed in the herein attached summary and certified by the NTF-ELCAC: PROVIDED, That each cleared barangay shall be allocated with an amount to be used for the following projects:(i) farmotomarket road; (ii) school building; (iii) water and sanitation system; (iv) health stations; and (v) electrification.

3. Growth Equity Fund. The amount of One Billion Pesos ( $\mathrm{P} 1,000,000,000$ ) appropriated herein shall be used as financial assistance to the identified poor, disadvantaged, and lagging LGUs, using the following criteria as bases: (i) income bracket; (ii) poverty incidence; (iii) per capita FY 2023 National Tax Allotment; and (iv) such other criteria to be determined by the DBCC, for the implementation of priority projects to gradually enable the full and efficient implementation of the functions and services devolved to the local government.

Release of funds shall be subject to the guidelines to be issued by the DBCC, pursuant to E. 0 . No. 138, s. 2021, and its IRR
4. Availability of Funds. The amounts appropriated as Local Government Support Fund shall be available for release, obligation and disbursement for the purpose specified until December 31, 2024. The released amount shall be deposited in a trust fund. After the end of validity period, any unreleased appropriations shall lapse, while undisbursed funds shall revert to the unappropriated surplus of the General Fund in accordance with Section 28, Chapter 4, Book VI of E. O. No. 292, s. 1987.

In addition to the BARMM shares appropriated herein, the amount of Sixty Four Billion Seven Hundred Fifty Five Million Five Hundred One Thousand Pesos ( $\mathrm{P} 64,755,501,000$ ) is automatically appropriated for the share of the BaRMM in the national internal revenue tax collections of the BIR and the collections of the BOC in accordance with Sections 15 to 18, Article XII of R.A.
