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## SPECIAL PROVISION(S)

. Meat Inspection Service Development Fund. In addition to the amounts appropriated herein, One Hundred Seven Million Forty Five Thousand Pesos (P107,045,000) and Sixty One Million Pesos (P61,000,000) shall be used for the implementation of the Meat Establishment Improvement Project and Meat Inspection Service Development Project, respectively, sourced from fees, fines and charges collected by the National Meat Inspection Service (NMIS), constituted into the Meat Inspection Service Development Fund in accordance with Section 47 of R.A. No. 9296, as amended.

Release of funds shall be subject to Joint DA-DILG-DBM MC No. 01 dated October 17, 2006 and to the submission of a Special Budget pursuant to Section 35, Chapter 5, Book VI of E.O. No. 292, s. 1987.

The NMIS shall submit to the DBM, the Speaker of the House of Representatives and the President of the Senate of the Philippines, either in printed form or by way of electronic document, quarterly reports on financial and physical accomplishments. The Director of NMIS and the Agency's web administrator or his/her equivalent shall be responsible for ensuring that said quarterly reports are likewise posted on the NMIS website.
