SPECIAL PROVISION(S)

- 1. Subsidy to the Local Water Utilities Administration. The amount of Five Hundred Twenty Six Million Five Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P526,550,000) appropriated herein under the subsidy to the LWUA shall be used for the implementation of sanitation projects in the Manila Bay Continuing Mandamus-covered areas.
- 2. Prior Years' Subsidy Releases from the National Government. The LWUA is hereby authorized to use subsidy released for progams and projects in 2016-2021 to cover the additional funding requirements of activities or projects covered by the programs or sub-programs indicated under the Water Convergence Program: The Unified Financing Framework for Water Supply and Sanitation (UFF-WSS). Accordingly, the LWUA shall prepare a work and financial plan covering the projects or activities to be funded from prior years' subsidies subject to the endorsement of LWUA's Board members, to be submitted to the DBM for approval.
- 3. Special Provisions Applicable to All Government Corporations. In addition to the foregoing special provisions, the special provisions applicable to all government corporations enumerated under the Budgetary Support to Government Corporations-Others shall be observed by the LWUA.
