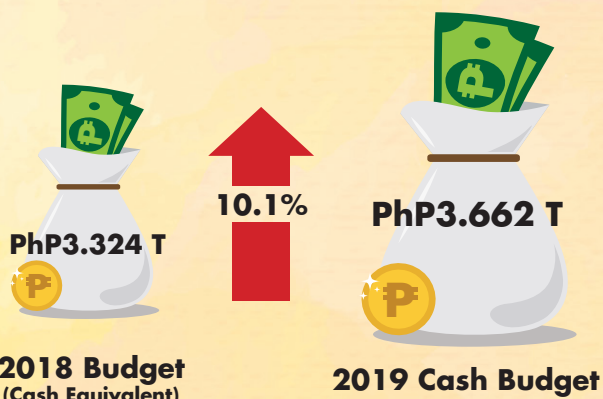


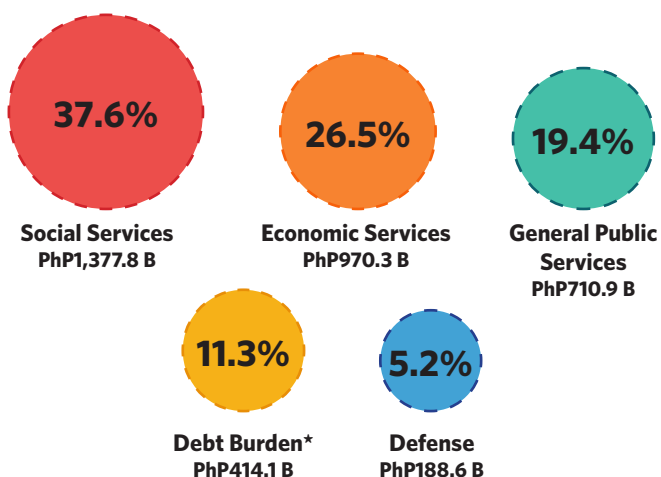
2019 NATIONAL BUDGET

Building a Bright Future for the Philippines and Its People



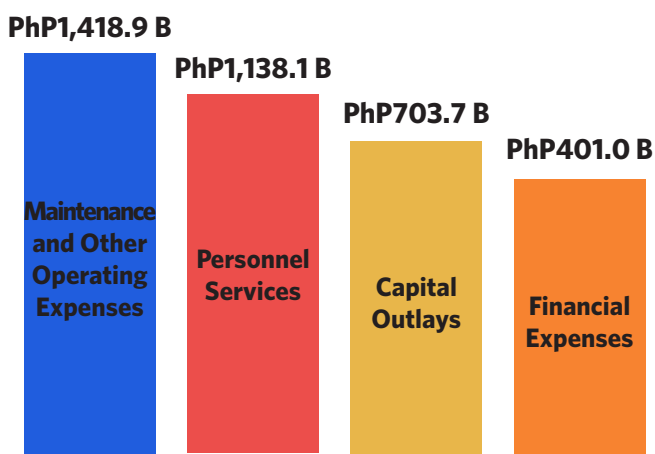
The **PhP3.662 trillion** National Cash Budget for 2019, which is 10.1% higher than its 2018 cash equivalent of PhP3.324 trillion, starts a new chapter in the Philippine Budgeting System. As the country's first ever cash budget, it will only fund implementation-ready programs and projects in 2019—clearly showing how the Duterte Administration stays true to its commitment of ensuring that every Filipino will have a bright future.

Budget Dimensions by Sector



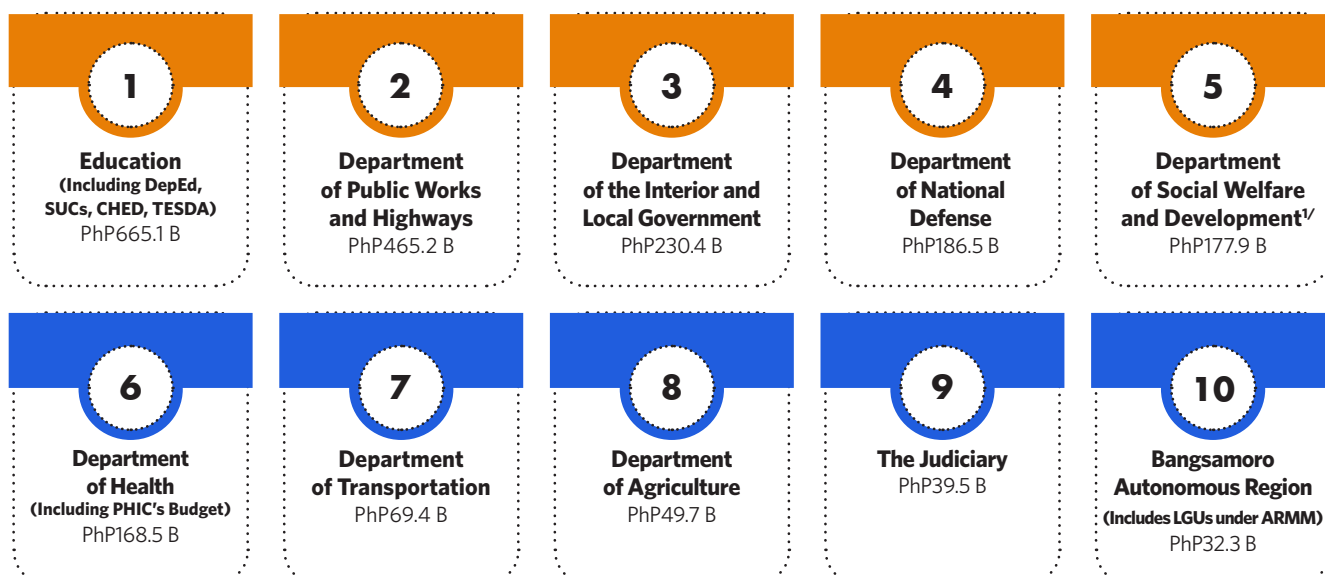
