SUBJECT : Amendments to CSC-DBM Joint Circular (JC) No. 2, s. 2004 re: Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered

This Circular is being issued to amend Section 5.5.2 of CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 dated October 4, 2004, on the accrual and use of Compensatory Overtime Credits (CCCs), and Section 8 (Saving Clause) theoref to delineate the roles of the CSC and DBM in the resolution of issues or conflicts arising from the involvementation of said Circular.

Section 5.5.2 is nereby american to read as follows:

"5.5.2 The COCs should be used as time-off within the year these are earned until the immediately succeeding year. Thereafter, any unutilized COCs are deemed forfeited."

Section 8.0 is hereby amended to read as follows:

.0 Saving Clause

Issues or conflicts on the procedure for accrual of COCs and availment of CTOs shall be referred to the CSC for resolution. All other issues on the implementation of this Circular shall be resolved by the DBM."

4.0 This Circular shall take effect immediately
