	 the Project, and to respond to questions and clarifications from the prospective bidders. Atty, Kieth Francis Briones, the TWG member-in-charge presented the technical and financial requirements of the Project, with emphasis on the common reasons for disqualification.
	• Engr. Argee Sta. Barbara, one of the end-user representatives, mentioned that a bidder can avail a copy of the blue print of the Project Plan but is required to sign a Non-disclosure Agreement. He shall also accompany all bidders to a site inspection after the meeting.
	 The following were also discussed: 1. Similar contract shall be "Structured Cabling." 2. End-user shall evaluate the Schedule of Delivery 3. The number of cameras from the lay-out and the Terms of Reference
	A Supplemental Bid Document shall be issued regarding revisions on the Schedule of Requirements and Technical Specifications.

Supply, Delivery, Installation, Testing and Commissioning of IP-CCTV Surveillance System for the DBM Central Office	• After careful evaluation, validation, and verification of the eligibility and technical proposals, the TWG member-incharge of the Project found that the submission of Faire Technologies Inc. failed the criteria for post-qualification for failing to submit certificates for the required professionals for the Project, as specified in Item 5.3, V. Scope of Work, Annex A. Terms of Reference of the Bidding Documents.
	The BAC instructed the BAC Secretariat and the TWG to notify bidder in writing about its post-disqualification and the grounds for it.

Supply, Delivery, Fabrication, Installation, Testing, and Commissioning of Brand New Passenger Elevators for the DBM Arcache Building	• After careful evaluation, validation, and verification of the eligibility and technical proposals, the TWG member-incharge of the Project found that the submission of IFE Elevators Philippines Inc. passed all the criteria for post-qualification.
