


PROCUREMENT TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. The Total Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) is **One Hundred Fifty Five Thousand Three Hundred Pesos only (P155,300.00)**.
2. Price quotation should be inclusive of tax obligations.
3. **Evaluation of bids will be conducted on a "per lot" basis.**
4. Delivery period is **two (2) calendar days** upon receipt of the Notice of Award (NOA) and Purchase Order (PO) at the DBM-Regional Office VIII, Marasbaras, Tacloban City.
5. If awarded the contract, processing and payment shall be made within **seven (7) working days** upon receipt of Statement of Account after successful testing duly inspected by a Master Plumber/Registered Engineer from any government institution commissioned by the office.
6. Refusal to accept an award maybe ground for imposition of administrative sanctions under Rule XXIII of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184.
7. Failure of the supplier to deliver goods and render services under the contract within the specified delivery schedule shall be liable for damages for the delay pursuant to Sec. 3 Annex D of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184.
