Resolution No. 2020-69

WHEREAS, the Department of Budget and Management-Bids and Awards Committee (DBM-BAC) conducted Public Bidding for the Project, "Cleaning Services for the Air-conditioning Units located at the DBM Central Office and Arcache Building," with an Approved Budget for the Contract of P**4,000,000.00**, through the authorized appropriations under the FY 2021 General Appropriations Act (GAA), as reflected in the Indicative Annual Procurement Plan, CY 2021;

WHEREAS, for the purpose of early procurement authorized under Section 7.6 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184, the proposed budget under the FY 2021 National Expenditure Program shall be used as basis;

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2020, the Invitation to Bid was posted on the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System website, the DBM website, and all DBM bulletin boards;

WHEREAS, two (2) prospective bidders, namely: (i) Rose Aire Enterprise Inc. (Rose Aire); and (ii) EM Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Services (EMRACS), responded to the said Invitation and attended the Pre-bid Conference via videoconferencing on November 17, 2020;

WHEREAS, Supplemental/Bid Bulletin No. 1 was issued on November 24, 2020 to clarify, modify or amend items in the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, during the submission and opening of bids on December 1, 2020, two bidders submitted bids, namely: (i) EMRACS; and (ii) Rose Aire;

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2020, after preliminary examination of the bids, the DBM-BAC, using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criteria, determined the following:

- 1) The submission of EMRACS as "passed" for complying with all the eligibility and technical requirements as stated in the Bidding Documents; and
- 2) The submission of Rose Aire as "failed" for non-compliance with the prescribed requirement for the Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the Project, which should have been "completed within two (2) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids" as explicitly stated in Clause 10.2 of Section II. Instructions to Bidders (ITB), as reiterated in Section III. Bid Data Sheet, referring to Clause 5.3.b of the ITB, of the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, after evaluation of the financial proposal of EMRACS, the BAC declared the submission of EMRACS as the Single Calculated Bid in the amount of P3,483,200.00;

WHEREAS, after careful examination, validation and verification, the DBM-BAC determined that the eligibility, technical and financial components of the bid of EMRACS have passed all the criteria for post-qualification;

WHEREAS, through letter dated December 1, 2020,¹ Rose Aire sought reconsideration of the DBM-BAC's declaration of its submission as "failed". It contended that, "[i]n general condition, a project is not considered done and completed until the end-user/client acknowledged and issued a Certificate of Completion and/or Acceptance. The date of Certification of Completion issued to RAE Inc. by BAC was dated December 3, 2018. It has been completed within two (2) years prior to the deadline for the submission and receipt of bids which is on December 1, 2020";

WHEREAS, the DBM-BAC, in its letter-reply dated December 7, 2020² to Rose Aire, explained, among others, that the SLCC requirement is pursuant to Section 23.1.a (v) of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184 which prescribes the submission, as part of the Technical Documents, of the "Statement of the bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract similar to the contract to be bid, except under conditions provided for in Sections 23.4.1.3 and 23.4.2.4 of this IRR, within the relevant period as provided in the Bidding Documents in the case of Goods", thus, the DBM-BAC denied the request for reconsideration of Rose Aire, and affirmed its declaration finding the submitted bid of Rose Aire as "failed";

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 55 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184, Rose Aire has seven (7) calendar days upon receipt of the said letter on December 8, 2020, or until December 15, 2020, to protest the DBM-BAC's decision by filing a verified position paper, accompanied by the payment of a non-refundable protest fee, before the Head of the Procuring Entity;

WHEREAS, Section 57 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184 provides that, "[i]n no case shall any protest taken from any decision treated in this Rule stay or delay the bidding process: Provided, however, That protests must first be resolved before any award is made";

WHEREAS, upon verification with the DBM Central Records Division on December 16, 2020, it was gathered that Rose Aire did not file a protest within the reglementary period;

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the DBM-BAC **RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVED**, the following:

- 1) To declare the bid of EM Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Services for the Project, "Cleaning Services for the Air-conditioning Units located at the DBM Central Office and Arcache Building," in the amount of P3,483,200.00 as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid, in accordance with Section 36 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184;
- 2) To notify all other bidders, in writing, of the DBM-BAC's recommendation within three (3) calendar days from the issuance of the Resolution recommending award of the contract, pursuant to Section 37.1.1 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184;

- 3) To recommend to the Secretary of the Department of Budget and Management, as the Head of the Procuring Entity, that the contract for the Project be awarded to EM Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Services in the above-mentioned amount, in accordance with Section 36, in relation to Section 34.4, of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184; and
- 4) To issue the Notice of Award to EM Refrigeration and Air Conditioning Services upon the enactment of the FY 2021 GAA, pursuant to Section 7.6 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

This CONTRACT made and entered into by and between the following:

DEPARTMENT OF BUDGET AND MANAGEMENT, a government agency created by virtue of the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with principal office address at General Solano St., San Miguel, Manila, represented herein by its **SECRETARY**, **WENDEL E. AVISADO**, hereinafter called the "**DBM**";

and –

EM REFRIGERATION AND AIR CONDITIONING SERVICES, a sole proprietorship duly organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines, with office address at 6384 M.H. del Pilar St., La Huerta, Paranaque City, represented by ITS AUTHORIZED REPRESENTATIVE, EDWARD S. MENDOZA, hereinafter referred to as the "SUPPLIER";

Collectively, the "PARTIES";

WITNESSETH:

WHEREAS, the DBM conducted a public bidding for the Project, "Cleaning Services for the Air-conditioning Units located at the DBM Central Office and Arcache Building," and the bid of the Supplier was declared as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid in the amount of Three Million Four Hundred Eighty-Three Thousand Two Hundred Pesos (P3,483,200.00), hereinafter called the "Contract Price";

whereas, pursuant to Sections 37 and 39 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, the Notice of Award was issued to the Supplier last <u>January 4, 2021</u>, and the Supplier posted its performance security in the form of a <u>Performance Security bedantion</u> on <u>January 6, 2021</u>, in the amount of (P N/RE);

The DBM hereby covenants to pay the Supplier, in consideration of the provision of the Goods and Services, which is the Cleaning Services for the Air-conditioning Units located at the DBM Central Office and Arcache Building, and the remedying of defects therein, the Contract Price or such other sum as may become payable under the provisions of the Contract at the time and in the manner prescribed by the Contract.
- 5. The period for the performance of the obligations under this Contract shall not go beyond the validity of the appropriation for this Project.
- 6. Entire Agreement. All parties agree that this Contract, including the attached Annexes, contains their full agreement and supersedes all previous agreements, either written or oral, if there are any. 4 Scope of Services

COMPLY

- a. The Contractor shall conduct a pre-implementation meeting with the Administrative Service (AS) to finalize and discuss all matters necessary for the contract implementation.
- b. The Contractor shall submit a definite monthly and quarterly schedule for the whole duration of the contract, subject to the approval of the AS. In case of changes of the number of air conditioning units, the Contractor shall submit a revise monthly and quarterly schedule, accordingly.
- c. The Contractor shall submit a list of personnel who will be assigned in the DBM during the contract implementation, together with a copy of their resume/personal information sheet, license/s and or certifications.
- d. The Contractor's cleaning team, assigned to the DBM, must have the following:
 - At least two (2) personnel with TESDA Refrigeration and Air conditioning Servicing (RAC) National Certificate II (NCII);
 - One (1) Safety Officer with Department of Labor and Employment (DOLE) Occupational Safety and Health Center (OSHC) training certificate; and
 - · Licensed Mechanical Engineer

The Safety Officer and Licensed Mechanical Engineer shall always be present during the conduct of any cleaning activity within the DBM.

- e. The contractor shall ensure that, during contract implementation, the assigned cleaning team complies with the minimum health standards and safety protocols imposed by the DBM. In particular, all members of the cleaning team should wear proper personal protective equipment/clothing/supplies during the conduct of cleaning activity.
- f. The Contractor shall accomplish a work permit form prior to the conduct of cleaning services and must register at the lobby guard upon arrival at the DBM buildings.
- g. The Contractor shall submit an accomplishment report (soft and hard copy) for each visit/scheduled cleaning to the AS on the following working day after the conduct of the activity. The contractor must indicate in the report about any defects found in the air conditioning unit/s.
- h. All tools and tackles, manpower, transportation and other resources required for executing the job shall be in the scope of the Contractor, with no additional cost to the DBM. Cleaning tools and equipment will be stored at the storage room provided by the DBM for the duration of the contract.

- The rates quoted by the Contractor shall include all liabilities such as supervision, wages, overtime pay, leave, bonus, increment, insurance and all other statutory payments including provision of tools and tackles, under contractor's scope of supply, overheads, profits, etc.
- The Contractor shall be held liable for: j.
 - any work-related damages incurred by their staff to air conditioning unit/s or any DBM property
 - any work-related accident or illness inflicted by and to their own personnel during the activity

Note: Quantity of air conditioning units is indicative number and for bidding purposes only. The DBM-AS may decrease the number of units requiring cleaning services during contract implementation. In such case, there shall be a corresponding adjustment in the cost, as well as revision on the monthly and quarterly schedule, of cleaning services.

Section IV. General Conditions of Contract

1. Scope of Contract

This Contract shall include all such items, although not specifically mentioned, that can be reasonably inferred as being required for its completion as if such items were expressly mentioned herein. All the provisions of RA No. 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR, including the Generic Procurement Manual, and associated issuances, constitute the primary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract, and thus, applicable in contract implementation. Herein clauses shall serve as the secondary source for the terms and conditions of the Contract.

This is without prejudice to Sections 74.1 and 74.2 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184 allowing the GPPB to amend the IRR, which shall be applied to all procurement activities, the advertisement, posting, or invitation of which were issued after the effectivity of the said amendment.

Additional requirements for the completion of this Contract shall be provided in the **Special Conditions of Contract (SCC).**

2. Advance Payment and Terms of Payment

- 2.1. Advance payment of the contract amount is provided under Annex "D" of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 2.2. The Procuring Entity is allowed to determine the terms of payment on the partial or staggered delivery of the Goods procured, provided such partial payment shall correspond to the value of the goods delivered and accepted in accordance with prevailing accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The terms of payment are indicated in the SCC.

3. Performance Security

Within ten (10) calendar days from receipt of the Notice of Award by the Bidder from the Procuring Entity but in no case later than prior to the signing of the Contract by both parties, the successful Bidder shall furnish the performance security in any of the forms prescribed in Section 39 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

4. Inspection and Tests

The Procuring Entity or its representative shall have the right to inspect and/or to test the Goods to confirm their conformity to the Project specifications at no extra cost to the Procuring Entity in accordance with the Generic Procurement Manual. In addition to tests in the SCC, Section IV (Technical Specifications) shall specify what inspections and/or tests the Procuring Entity requires, and where they are to be conducted. The Procuring Entity shall notify the Supplier in writing, in a timely manner, of the identity of any representatives retained for these purposes.

All reasonable facilities and assistance for the inspection and testing of Goods, including access to drawings and production data, shall be provided by the Supplier to the authorized inspectors at no charge to the Procuring Entity.

5. Warranty

- 5.1 In order to assure that manufacturing defects shall be corrected by the Supplier, a warranty shall be required from the Supplier as provided under Section 62.1 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.
- 5.2 The Procuring Entity shall promptly notify the Supplier in writing of any claims arising under this warranty. Upon receipt of such notice, the Supplier shall, repair or replace the defective Goods or parts thereof without cost to the Procuring Entity, pursuant to the Generic Procurement Manual.

6. Liability of the Supplier

The Supplier's liability under this Contract shall be as provided by the laws of the Republic of the Philippines.

If the Supplier is a joint venture, all partners to the joint venture shall be jointly and severally liable to the Procuring Entity.

In the case of Goods supplied from within the Philippines or supplied by domestic Suppliers risk and title will not be deemed to have passed to the Procuring Entity until their receipt and final acceptance at the final destination.
