Resolution No. 2025-33

WHEREAS, the Department of Budget and Management-Bids and Awards Committee (DBM-BAC) conducted a Public Bidding for the Project, "Replacement of Floor Tiles and Repainting of the Interior Walls and Finishes of the Corporate Planning and Management Service (CPMS) Office," with an Approved Budget for the Contract of P2,632,000.00 through the Continuing Appropriations, FY 2024 General Appropriations Act, as reflected in the Supplemental Annual Procurement Plan No. 3, CY 2025;

WHEREAS, on April 29, 2025, the Invitation to Bid for the Project was posted on the Philippine Government Electronic Procurement System (PhilGEPS) website, the DBM website, the official DBM Facebook page, and all DBM bulletin boards;

WHEREAS, only one (1) prospective bidder, DRP Building Specialties Home Repair and Maintenance Services, attended the Pre-bid Conference on May 6, 2025;

WHEREAS, only one (1) bidder, Master Son Builders, submitted a bid during the submission and opening of bids on May 20, 2025;

WHEREAS, after preliminary examination of the bid, the DBM-BAC, using non-discretionary "pass/fail" criteria, determined the submission of Master Son Builders as "passed" for complying with all the eligibility and technical requirements as stated in the Bidding Documents;

WHEREAS, after evaluation of the financial component of the bid of Master Son Builders, the DBM-BAC declared the submission of Master Son Builders as the Single Calculated Bid in the amount of P2,630,000.00;

WHEREAS, after verification, validation, and ascertainment of all statements made and documents submitted by Master Son Builders, using non-discretionary criteria, as stated in the Bidding Documents, it was determined that the submission of Master Son Builders passed all the criteria for post-qualification;

WHEREAS, Section 36 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act (RA) No. 9184 provides, among others, that a single calculated and responsive bid shall be considered for award if only one bidder submits a bid, and its bid is found to be responsive to the bidding requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the DBM-BAC **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, the following:

- 1) To declare the bid of Master Son Builders for the Project, "Replacement of Floor Tiles and Repainting of the Interior Walls and Finishes of the Corporate Planning and Management Service (CPMS) Office," in the amount of P2,630,000.00 as the Single Calculated and Responsive Bid, in accordance with Section 34.4 in relation to Section 36 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184; and
- 2) To recommend to the DBM Head of the Procuring Entity that the contract for the Project be awarded to Master Son Builders in the above-mentioned amount, in accordance with Section 37.1.1 of the same IRR.

If the bidder with the LCRB, HRRB, SCRB or SRRB fails, refuses or is unable to submit the documents required under Section 37.1 of this IRR or to make good its bid by entering into a contract with the Procuring Entity or post the required Performance Security within the period stipulated in this IRR or in the Bidding Documents, the bid security shall be forfeited and the appropriate sanctions provided in this IRR and existing laws shall be imposed, except where such failure, refusal or inability is through no fault of the said bidder.
