This SBB No. 1 dated December 3, 2021 for **Project No. DBM-2022-20**, "**Procurement of Petroleum, Oil, and Lubricants,**" is issued pursuant to Section 22.5 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 9184, to clarify, modify or amend items in the Bidding Documents. Accordingly, this shall form an integral part of the Bidding Documents.

This is consistent with ITB Clause 5.3 of the Bid Data Sheet, Section III of the Bidding Documents, which prescribes, among others, as follows:

"For this purpose, contracts similar to the Project shall:

- a. refer to:
 - i. the provision of petroleum with a fleet card system; and/or
 - ii. the provision of petroleum, oil and lubricants, including labor services, with a fleet card system; or
 - iii. a combination of at least one contract falling under the category 'a.i.' or 'a.ii.', and at least one contract for provision of petroleum; and

xxx" (emphasis supplied)

2. Regarding the Provision of Free 24-Hour Towing and Roadside Assistance, may the following conditions be considered/accepted: (i) Exclude incidents arising from acts of God, like floods, typhoons, earthquake, and other similar occurrences; and (ii) Towing within city limits is free of charge only up to P5,000.00.

3. What should we indicate in the bid form for the price of diesel and gasoline? How to reflect the discount we are offering?

2. As provided in item 4.0 of Annex A (Detailed Technical Specifications) of Section VII. Technical Specifications of the Bidding Documents for the Project, the Contractor shall provide free 24-hour towing and roadside assistance for all DBM's official vehicles, which are not older than 10 years.

Hence, the free 24-hour towing and roadside assistance for all DBM's official vehicles which are not older than 10 years should not be qualified by any other condition such as those enumerated in the query.

3. Please note that the amount that will be provided for the provision of petroleum (diesel and gasoline) should be within the price range as specified for Manila in the Department of Energy Report for NCR Prevailing Retail Pump Price as of October 7, 2021 in order for the bid to be compliant. However, during contract implementation, the prevailing pump prices shall be the basis of the billing, provided that the total amount billed shall not exceed the total contract cost.

As to the discount, based on further evaluation, the provision on discounts or rebates was deleted from the Bid Form for the following considerations:

- The discounts/rebates, expressed in total amount may not be appropriate to be deducted from the Total Annual Cost in the Bid Form since the quantities reflected are indicative. Deducting only discounts/rebates from the Total Annual Cost in the Bid Form, at amounts based on indicative quantities, will have unintended effect of reducing the Contract Cost should the bid be subsequently determined and declared as the winning bid in accordance with the applicable rules.
- On the other hand, discounts/rebates, as applied to the provision of oil and lubricants, and the provision of change oil services and related parts and services (as a package), may already be considered in the unit cost to be proposed by the bidder in the Bid Form.

- 4. Will there be a price range for the provision of oil and lubricants and change oil services, or will we quote our prices based on our projections?
- 5. Relative to the provision of oil and lubricants and the provision of change oil services, how often is the monitoring to ensure that it is within the contract cost?

This adjustment is reflected as an amendment in the Bid Form as detailed above.

- 4. The costs indicated in the Bid Form for the provision of oil and lubricants, and the provision of change oil services and related parts and services (as a package) are the same costs to be applied during contract implementation.
- 5. The DBM, through the Administrative Services-General Services Division, has a monthly monitoring to check continued compliance with the contract for the project.

Other matters:

- The "No Contact Rule" shall be strictly observed. Bidders are not allowed to call or talk to any member of the Bids and Awards Committee, Technical Working Group or Secretariat effective December 10, 2021 right after the opening of bids.
