Queries:	Clarifications:
1. Do prospective bidders need to pay the Bidding Documents if they previously bought the previous Bidding Documents for the Project?	1. Prospective bidders who who have paid for the Bidding Documents fee for the first bidding do not need to pay for the second bidding; provided, however, that they are participating as the same entity.
	Moreover, if the prospective bidders participated as a Joint Venture (JV) during the previous bidding, the same JV is not anymore required to pay for the Bidding Documents fee.
	However, if they are participating as a separate entity than the JV who participated in the previous bidding, they are required to pay for the Bidding Documents fee.
2. What is the requirement for those with expired Mayor's/Business Permit?	2. In case of a recently expired Mayor's/Business Permit, Section 23.1.a.ii of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184 states that a recently expired Mayor's/Business permit together with the official receipt, as proof that the prospective bidder has applied for renewal within the period prescribed by the concerned local government unit, shall be accepted by the PhilGEPS for the purpose of updating the PhilGEPS Certificate of Registration and Membership in accordance with Section 8.5.2 of this IRR.
	Thus, bidders are only required to submit the aforementioned permit to the PhilGEPS.

	However, as an additional post-qualification requirement for the Lowest Calculated Bidder with an expired Mayor's/Business Permit at the time of bid submission, its valid Mayor's/Business Permit shall be submitted within five (5) calendar days from its receipt of the notice from the BAC of its declaration as such, in accordance with Section 34.2 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184.

- The "No Contact Rule" shall be strictly observed. Bidders are not allowed to communicate with any member of the Bids and Awards Committee, Technical Working Group or Secretariat effective February 13, 2024 right after the opening of bids.

- a. Pursuant to Section 23.4.1.3 of the 2016 Revised IRR of RA No. 9184, the Bidder shall have an SLCC that is at least one (1) contract similar to the Project, the value of which, adjusted to current prices using the PSA's CPI, must be at least equivalent to the following requirements:
  - i. a single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC; <u>OR</u>
