Resolution No. 2024-67

WHEREAS, the Department of Budget and Management-Bids and Awards Committee (DBM-BAC) conducted a Negotiated Procurement–Two Failed Biddings for the Project, “Managed Services for the Development of Microservices for the Identity and Access Management (IAM) of the Department of Budget and Management (DBM),” with an Approved Budget for the Contract of P21,000,000.00 through the authorized appropriations under the FY 2024 General Appropriations Act (GAA), as reflected in the Supplemental Annual Procurement Plan No. 8, CY 2024;

WHEREAS, on June 25, 2024, the Invitation for Negotiation and Request for Submission of Proposals for the Project was posted on the PhilGEPS website, the DBM website, the official DBM Facebook page, and all DBM bulletin boards;

WHEREAS, six (6) prospective bidders/interested consultants, namely: (i) SyCip Gorres Velayo & Co.; (ii) Collabera Technologies Pvt. Ltd (Collabera Digital); (iii) Mybusybee, Inc.; (iv) Via Appia Philippines, Inc. (Via Appia); (v) Innove Communications, Inc.; and (vi) ThinkBIT Solutions, responded to the said Invitation and attended the negotiation meeting on July 2, 2024 to negotiate and discuss the technical and financial requirements of the project to be able to submit a responsive proposal;

WHEREAS, during the submission and opening of the Best Offers based on the eligibility documents, technical and financial requirements on July 26, 2024, two bidders submitted their offers, namely: (i) Via Appia; and (ii) R.G. Manabat & Co. (KPMG in the Philippines) (R.G. Manabat);


WHEREAS, under DBM-BAC Resolution No. 2024-61 dated August 6, 2024, the DBM-BAC recommended the declaration of Via Appia Philippines, Inc. (Via Appia) as the bidder with the Single Rated Bid for the Project, and the same was approved by the Secretary as the Head of the Procuring Entity (HoPE) on August 20, 2024;

WHEREAS, after verification, validation, and ascertainment of all statements made and documents submitted by Via Appia, using non-discretionary criteria, as stated in the Bidding Documents, the DBM-BAC determined that the submission of Via Appia passed all the criteria for post-qualification; thus, it was declared as the Single Rated and Responsive Bid in the amount of P20,804,414.40.

NOW, THEREFORE, for and in consideration of the foregoing premises, the BAC **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to recommend to the DBM Secretary, as the HoPE, that the contract for the Project be awarded to Via Appia Philippines, Inc. in the above-mentioned amount, in accordance with Republic Act No. 9184 and its 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations.

If the bidder with the LCRB, HRRB, SCRB or SRRB fails, refuses or is unable to submit the documents required under Section 37.1 of this IRR or to make good its bid by entering into a contract with the Procuring Entity or post the required Performance Security within the period stipulated in this IRR or in the Bidding Documents, the bid security shall be forfeited and the appropriate sanctions provided in this IRR and existing laws shall be imposed, except where such failure, refusal or inability is through no fault of the said bidder.
