Special Provisions

1. Land and Home Development and Improvement Projects. The amount allotted for land and home development and improvement projects may be used for development projects such as construction and repair of roads, bridges, irrigation systems, artesian wells, waterworks, including project or field agency offices, cost of land clearing, and maintenance and repair of heavy equipment. Such amounts as may be necessary may be allotted for special projects for the establishment of nursery, livestock and poultry projects and cooperatives, including projects for home development and industries: PROVIDED, That the Minister of Agrarian Reform shall coordinate with the Ministry of Public Works and Highways for the technical supervision of projects.

2. Land Surveys. The amount allotted for land surveys may be spent for subdivision surveys of settlement areas and private lands acquired by the Ministry, boundary surveys of land proclaimed or set aside by the defunct National Resettlement and Rehabilitation Administration (NARRA), the Land Tenure Administration (LTA), and the Land Authority (LA), which may be undertaken by administration or by private land surveyors, subject to auditing rules and regulations and public bidding: PROVIDED, That in the updating of surveys in the land acquired by the defunct offices, the Ministry, for reasons of economy and expediency may undertake such surveys with its own personnel and resources.

3. Loan Assistance. The amounts allotted herein for loan assistance, either in cash or in kind, shall include provisions for transportation to farmers/settlers (including their belongings, work animals and farm equipment) houses and housing materials, subsistence, supplies, farm equipment, work animals, soil conditioners and fertilizers, seedlings and seed stock, supplies and materials, staple vegetable seeds, land titles, and other direct assistance, income-generating activities of the rural women, students and out-of-school youth within the resettle-

ment areas and landed estates administered by the Ministry of Agrarian Reform: PROVIDED, That the loan fund herein appropriated for loan assistance shall be utilized thru the Ministry of Agrarian Reform, government financial institutions or the private banking system as may be approved by the President in support of the resettlement program.

4. Revolving Funds. The income derived from the operation of Tractor Pools and sale of photomaps shall be constituted as separate revolving funds solely for the maintenance and operation of the said Pools and for the maintenance of tractor equipment and procurement of photo supplies, respectively. The income shall be deposited in an authorized government depository bank and shall be withdrawn by means of checks to be drawn by a duly authorized representative of the Ministry and countersigned by the Resident Auditor. Any interest earned in such deposit shall accrue to the Revolving Funds. A monthly report of income and a quarterly report of expenditures shall be submitted to the Office of Budget and Management and in case of failure to submit said requirements, the Office of Budget and Management shall order the suspension of withdrawals from the funds until such time that said requirements are complied with.
