Special Provisions

1. Release of Funds for Puericulture Centers. The appropriations herein provided for puericulture centers shall be released only in amounts equivalent to the funds raised by the respective local governments for said purpose, as certified by the Treasurer concerned.

2. Fund for Medicines and Drugs Including Medical Supplies. The Minister of Health shall authorize and fix the amounts for each hospital out of its appropriations for maintenance and other operating expenses to be earmarked for the purchase of medicines and drugs, including such types of medical supplies as are specifically authorized by the Ministry of Health, with the concurrence of the Commission on Audit and the Office of Budget and Management, for stock and resale. The amounts so fixed shall constitute the ceiling thereof. The proceeds

from the sale (cost plus profit) of medicines, drugs and medical supplies in stock shall be deposited in an authorized government depository bank and may be made available for the procurement of medicines and drugs, including medical supplies either for replenishment or for increase in the ceiling previously authorized. Withdrawals from the deposits shall be effected upon the joint signatures of the representatives of the hospital concerned and the Commission on Audit without the need for Cash Disbursement Ceiling: PROVIDED, That the cost of medicines and drugs including medical supplies dispensed to charity patients may be reimbursed with an equivalent amount from the regular appropriations of the hospital. The Chief of the Hospital concerned shall submit to the Office of Budget and Management a quarterly report of the status of the operation, indicating stock on hand and information on the items purchased and sold. In case of failure to submit the required report, the Office of Budget and Management shall order the suspension of all transactions on the operation until the hospital complies with the foregoing requirement.

3. Subsidy for Indigent Patients. The amount herein appropriated to cover the fees and charges for the utilization of specialized equipment in private hospitals or clinics which are not available in government hospitals shall be released and utilized in accordance with such rules and regulations as may be approved by the President upon the recommendation of the Minister of Health.

4. Support of Beds in Private Hospitals. The amount herein appropriated under the Ministry of Health may be used for the support of beds or wards in private hospitals in areas where there are inadequate government hospital facilities, as may be determined by the President, upon recommendation of the Minister of Health.

5. Release of Capital Outlays. The appropriations for capital outlays herein provided for the Ministry of Health for the construction of hospitals, sanitaria, health centers, clinics, herbal processing plants, warehouses and health stations, except those pertaining to foreignassisted projects, shall be released to the Ministry of Health which shall sub-allot the same to and be administered by, the Ministry of Public Works and Highways: PROVIDED, That the location, costing, design, and timetable shall be subject to approval of the Minister of Health.

6. Modification, Reallocation and Transfer. The programs, projects, activities, key budgetary inclusions, and appropriations authorized herein for current operating expenditures of the Ministry of Health shall be modified and/or reallocated to conform with the provisions of Executive Order No. 851, dated December 2, 1982 entitled "Reorganizing the Ministry of Health, Integrating the Components of Health Care Delivery into its Field Operations, and for Other Purposes", subject to Section 40 of P.D. No. 1177 and within the limits of the total appropriations herein authorized for current operating expenditures of the Ministry of Health. The transfer of appropriations shall, among other things, provide for the staff and line bureaus and offices created under E.O. No. 851.

1. Fund for Medicines and Drugs Including Medical Supplies. The Tondo Medical Center Board shall authorize and fix an amount out of the appropriations for maintenance and other operating expenses, to be earmarked for the purchase of medicines and drugs, including such types of medical supplies authorized by the Ministry of Health pursuant to Special Provision No. 2 of the Office of the Minister of Health, for stock and resale. The amounts so fixed shall constitute the ceiling thereof. The proceeds from sale (cost plus profit) of medicines, drugs and medical supplies in stock shall be deposited in an authorized government depository bank, and be made available for the procurement of medicines and drugs, including medical supplies either for replenishment or for increase in the ceiling previously authorized. Withdrawals from the deposits shall be effected upon the joint signatures of the representatives of the Tondo Medical Center and the Commission on Audit without the need for Cash Disbursement Ceiling: PROVIDED, That the cost of medicines and drugs including medical supplies dispensed to charity patients may be reimbursed with an

equivalent amount from the regular appropriations of the Center. The Chief of the Center shall submit to the Office of Budget and Management a quarterly report of the status of the operation, indicating stock on hand and information on the items purchased and sold. In case of failure to submit the required report, the Office of Budget and Management shall order the suspension of all transactions on the Fund until the Center complies with the foregoing requirements.
