Special Provisions

1. *Use of the Fund.* The amounts herein appropriated under Project 1.3 may be used to support operating expenses of the recipient government-owned or controlled corporations or agencies: PROVIDED, That payment of salaries, allowances and other benefits shall be in accordance with the provisions of P.D. No. 985: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That retirement gratuities paid from this fund shall be computed in accordance with the rates, conditions and procedures prescribed under existing retirement laws, rules and regulations: PROVIDED, FINALLY, That releases shall be subject to Section 40 of P.D. No. 1177.

2. *Subsidies to Government Corporations attached to the Ministry of Human Settlements.* All requests for fund release for subsidies to government corporations shall emanate from the Office of the Minister of Human Settlements. Corporations attached to the Ministry shall submit all requests for fund release through the Office of the Minister of Human Settlements pursuant to Section 15 of P.D. No. 1396.

3. *Administration of the Fund.* The amounts herein appropriated shall be administered by the Office of Budget and Management.

4. *Key Budgetary Inclusions (KBI).* The amounts herein appropriated for the program and projects of the fund shall specifically provide for the activities and purposes in the indicated amounts and conditions:
