Special Provisions

1. **Use of the Fund for Special Expenses.** The amount herein appropriated may be made available for contributions and/or costs of approved participation in international organizations in accordance with actual assessments and signed agreements, or hosting of conferences, and to support Philippine commitments to ASEAN Complementation Projects, including commodity price stabilization agreements, to be released in accordance with actual requirements, subject to Section 40, P.D. No. 1177.

2. **Administration of the Fund.** The amount herein authorized for payment of Contributions to International Organizations shall be administered by the Department of Foreign Affairs in coordination with the National Economic and Development Authority and the amount authorized for holding of International Conferences shall be administered by the Department of Budget and Management.

3. **Deficiency in Appropriation.** Any deficiency in the appropriations of the International Commitments Fund arising from the inflation adjustments and increase in the rates of subscriptions shall be charged against the other appropriate lump sum fund.

4. **Appropriations for Specific Purposes.** The amounts herein appropriated shall be used specifically for the following purposes in the indicated amounts and conditions:
