Special Provisions

1. Allocation and Identification of Appropriations. The amounts herein appropriated for maintenance and other operating expenses, including supplies and materials and equipment shall be identified in the Work and Financial Plan as to the Bureau/Office/Division/District of ultimate destination: PROVIDED, That supplies directly used by teachers shall be issued to them in the form of cash, in addition to the cash allowance authorized in this Act.

Maintenance and other operating expenses shall include provisions for the purchase of chalks, teacher record booklets, forms, erasers, medical and dental supplies for schools and

mobile clinics, and other essential supplies and materials of the Department.

2. Release and Administration of Funds for Construction, Repair, Rehabilitation, Replacement, Completion and Maintenance of School Buildings. The amounts herein appropriated for construction, repair, rehabilitation, replacement, completion and maintenance of school buildings shall be released to the Regional Offices of the Department of Public Works and Highways to be implemented by the respective district or city engineers with no imposition of engineering surcharges: PROVIDED, That the Parent-Teachers Association, if any, shall be given the highest priority to undertake minor repairs involving amounts not exceeding twenty thousand pesos (P20,000) under the technical supervision of the district or city engineer, which in no case shall be sub-contracted: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That secondary and collegiate schools are authorized to utilize the services of their students, during their vocational class periods, in the construction, repair, rehabilitation, replacement and/or completion of public or government-owned buildings and equipment as part of their vocational training.

An adequate amount shall immediately be released and made available to the Secretary of Public Works and Highways as standby funds for emergency repairs of school buildings damaged by

typhoons and other calamities.

3. Use of Savings for Scholarship. The Secretary of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports is hereby authorized, subject to Section 40 of P.D. No. 1177, to use on first priority, savings not exceeding thirty million pesos (P30,000,000) realized from its current year appropriations as additional funding for the implementation of the Study Now Pay Later Plan of the National Scholarship and Student Loan Center as authorized by law.

In order to spread the assistance as widely as possible, the size of financial assistance in higher education to students of families in depressed areas, for which funds have been allocated under this Act, shall approximate the average government subsidies to students in State Colleges and Universities: PROVIDED, That scholarship funds shall be equitably allocated to the different political regions of the country.

- 4. Income of Baguio Teachers Camp. Income of the Baguio Teachers Camp derived from rentals for the use of its buildings and facilities, board and lodging and other sources shall be constituted as a revolving fund. The income shall be deposited in an authorized government depository bank, and may be made available for direct maintenance and operating expenses incurred for the board and lodging of teachers-occupants and for the maintenance and other operating expenses, which may be withdrawn subject to accounting and auditing rules and regulations without need for a funding warrant: PROVIDED, That any interest income earned shall accrue to the revolving fund: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That the Baguio Teachers Camp shall submit to the Department of Budget and Management a monthly report of its income and a quarterly report of expenditures and, in case of failure to submit said requirements, the Department of Budget and Management shall order the suspension of withdrawals from this fund until such time that said requirements are complied with.
- 5. Use of Savings for Supplemental Cash Allowance of Teachers. The Secretary of the Department of Education, Culture and Sports is hereby authorized, subject to Section 40 of P.D. No. 1177, to use savings realized from its current year appropriations to augment the supplemental cash allowance of teachers for the purchase of chalks, erasers, forms and other classroom supplies and materials directly used for elementary classroom purposes in an amount not exceeding two bundred pesos (P200) each teacher per year.
- 6. Special and Work Study Grant to Returnees. The amounts herein appropriated for special and work study grant to returnees or their next of kin under Presidential Memorandum Order No. 597 shall be utilized in coordination with the Peace and Order Council created under Executive Order No. 309 dated November 11, 1987 as amended by Executive Order No. 317 dated February 5, 1988.
- 7. Allocation of School Teachers. The allocation of teachers for both secondary and elementary schools shall be apportioned equitably in all the legislative districts taking into account the enrolment of students and the number of schools needed to be established, among other

considerations.

- 8. Allocation of School Buildings. The allocation of school buildings, both foreign-funded and locally-funded, shall be apportioned equitably, taking into account the number of school children in all the legislative districts.
- 9. Support for Literacy Programs. Any portion of the appropriation provided for the Bureau of Elementary and Bureau of Secondary Education may be utilized to support adult literacy programs utilizing alternative delivary systems.
- 10. Appropriations for Specific Activities and Purposes. The amounts herein appropriated for the functions of the agency shall be used specifically for the following activities and purposes in the indicated amounts and conditions:

Additional funds for restoration of the Ayuntamiento may be secured from Chapter XLI. Property Replacement Fund.

Special Provisions

1. **Revolving Fund.** The National Museum is authorized to print, fabricate, reproduce and sell museum souvenirs, relics or publications and to use the proceeds thereof to constitute as a Revolving Fund of the museum shop.

The Fund shall be deposited in a savings account in an authorized government depository bank and withdrawable on the joint signatures of duly authorized representatives of the National Museum and the Commission on Audit without the need for a Funding Warrant: PROVIDED, That any interest earned shall accrue to the General Fund and shall be remitted to the National Treasury at the end of each quarter: PROVIDED, FURTHER, That quarterly reports of the fund transactions shall be submitted to the Department of Budget and Management and in case of failure to submit said requirement the Department of Budget and Management shall order the suspension of withdrawals from this fund until such time that said requirement is complied with.
