#### Special Provisions

1. Release of Funds for Puericulture Centers. The appropriations herein provided for puericulture centers shall be released giving priority to depressed areas only in amounts equivalent to funds raised by the respective local governments for said purpose, as certified by the treasurer concerned.

2. Subsidy for Indigent Patients. The amount herein appropriated to cover the fees and charges for the utilization of specialized equipment in private hospitals or clinics which are not available in government hospitals shall be released and utilized in accordance with such rules and regulations as may be approved by the President of the Philippines upon recommendation of the Secretary of Health.

3. Assistance to Indigent Patients in Private Hospitals. The amount herein appropriated under the Department of Health may be used for assistance to indigent patients who may be

confined in private hospitals in areas where there are inadequate government facilities, as may be determined by the President of the Philippines upon recommendation of the Secretary of Health.

4. **Release of Capital Outlays.** The appropriations for capital outlays herein provided for the Department of Health for the construction of hospitals, sanitarium, health centers, clinics, herbal processing plants, warehouses and health stations, including those pertaining to foreign-assisted projects, shall be released to and administered by the Department of Health.

5. **Authority to Undertake Bulk Purchases.** The Secretary of the Department of Health is authorized to undertake bulk procurement of drugs, medicines, medical and dental supplies, equipment and instruments for all the agencies and field units under its supervision to obtain volume discounts and ensure better quality of items delivered.

6. **Subsidy for Indigent Mental Patients.** The amount herein appropriated under the National Center for Mental Health may be used for the payment of allowance or subsidy for indigent patients placed under the Foster-Family Care Program at the rate not exceeding twenty five pesos (P25.00) per patient per day in accordance with such rules and regulations as may be approved by the Secretary of Health.

7. **Use of Savings.** The provisions of existing laws to the contrary notwithstanding, any savings in the appropriations authorized for the Department of Health may be used to augment the appropriations for the construction of new hospitals and/or expansion of authorized bed capacity of existing hospitals in the areas as may be provided by law.

8. **Appropriations for Specific Activities and Purposes.** The amounts herein appropriated for the functions of the agency shall be used specifically for the following activities and purposes in the indicated amounts and conditions:
