savings in the the Court's Appropriations. Any of any Item in Augmentation ppropriations for the Supreme Court and the Lower Courts may be utilized by the Chief Justice of he Supreme Court to augment any item of the Court's appropriations for: (a) printing of decisions and publication of "Philippine Reports"; (b) commutable terminal leaves of Justices and other ersonnel of the Supreme Court and payment of adjusted pension rates to retired Justices entitled hereto pursuant to Administrative Matter No. 91-8-225-C.A.; (c) repair, maintenance, improvement nd other operating expenses of the courts' libraries, including purchase of books and eriodicals; (d) purchase, maintenance and improvement of printing equipment; (e) necessary xpenses for the employment of temporary employees, contractual and casual employees, for judicial dministration; (f) maintenance and improvement of the Court's Electronic Data Processing System; q) extraordinary expenses of the Chief Justice, attendance in international conferences and onduct of training programs; (h) commutable transportation and representation allowances and ringe benefits for Justices, Clerks of Court, Court Administrator, Chiefs of Offices and other ourt personnel in accordance with the rates prescribed by law; and (i) compensation of ttorneys-de-officio: PROVIDED, That as mandated by LOI No. 489 any increases in salary and llowances shall be subject to the usual procedures and policies as provided for under P.D. No. 85 and other pertinent laws.

Use of Appropriations for Printing and/or Publication of the Philippine Reports. The upreme Court is authorized to use its appropriations allotted for printing and publication and to ngage the services of government and/or private printers in the printing and/or publication of Philippine Reports" and other judicial publications, subject to public bidding and to pertinent

accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
