1. Allocation and Release of Fund. The amount herein appropriated shall be apportioned among the local government units in accordance with the formula prescribed in Section 285 of R. A. No. 7160, the Local Government Code of 1991, after deducting fifty percent (50%) of the actual cost of devolution and the cost of city-funded hospitals as of December 31, 1992, subject to necessary adjustments as authorized under Section 284 of the Code. The Internal Revenue Allotment shall be released directly by the Department of Budget and Management to the local government units concerned.

2. Use of Funds. The amount herein appropriated shall, pursuant to Section 17(g) of the Code, provide for the cost of basic services and facilities enumerated under Section 17(b) thereof, particularly those devolved by the Department of Health, the Department of Social Welfare and Development, the Department of Agriculture, and the Department of Environment and Matural Resources as well as other agencies of the Mational Government, including (1) construction/improvement, repair and maintenance of local roads; (2) concrete barangay roads/multi-purpose pavements, construction and improvement program to be implemented in accordance with R.A. No. 6763; (3) construction, rehabilitation and improvement of devolved health workers pursuant to the provisions of R.A.
