Special Provision(s)

1. Subsidy for the National Health Insurance Program. The amount of Seventy One Billion Two Hundred Minety Two Million One Hundred Thirty One Thousand Pesos (P71,292,131,000) appropriated herein under the subsidy for the Mational Health Insurance Program shall be used for the health insurance premiums of indirect contributors composed of the following: (i) indigents under the National Household Targeting System for Poverty Reduction as identified by the DSMD; (ii) senior citizens pursuant to R.A. No. 10645; (iii) unemployed persons with disability as jointly determined by the DOM and the National Council for Disability Affairs; and (iv) financially-incapable Point-of-Service patients as identified by the DSMD or social welfare officers of the LGUs.

In no case shall Philhealth use the subsidy for the payment of personnel services and that the administrative cost shall not exceed five percent (5%) of the actual total premium collected from direct and indirect contributory members during the immediately preceding year in accordance with Section 12 of R.A. No. 11223.

Release of funds shall be subject to the submission of the following: (i) Board-approved Corporate Operating Budget which shall be compliant with organization, staffing, and position classification, and compensation standards as determined by the DBM; and (ii) billing indicating the names of enrollees approved by the PhilHealth Board. The DOH and PhilHealth shall ensure the conduct of special audit on the implementation of the National Health Insurance Program.

- 2. Payapa at Masaganang Pamayanan. The amount of Sixty One Million Two Hundred Twenty Mine Thousand Pesos (P61,229,000) appropriated herein shall be used for the health insurance premiums of the beneficiaries under the Payapa at Masaganang Pamayanan (PAMAMA) Program. The DOH, OPAPP, and PhilHealth shall ensure that there shall be no duplication of the enrolled beneficiaries with other indirect contributors covered by the above-mentioned subsidy under the immediately preceding Section, and with members of direct contributors.
- 3. Special Provisions Applicable to All Government Corporations. In addition to the foregoing special provisions, the special provisions applicable to all government corporations enumerated under the Budgetary Support to Government Corporations—Others shall be observed by the PhilBealth.
