## Special Provision(s)

**PROGRAMS** 

1. Subsidy to the Mational Housing Authority. The amount of Three Billion Four Hundred Fifty Six Million Pesos (P3,456,000,000) appropriated herein under the subsidy to the MHA shall be used in support of the implementation of priority programs and projects under the Lot Development and Provision of Housing and Community Facilities Sub-program in accordance with R.A. Mos. 7279 and 7835, particularly the resettlement in the high-risk and disaster prone areas.

Release of funds shall be subject to submission of the NHA Board-approved Implementing Rules and Regulations covering these priority programs and projects.

- 2. Prior Years' Subsidy Releases from the National Government. The NNA is hereby authorized to use subsidy released for programs and projects in 2018 and prior years to cover the additional funding requirements of activities or projects covered by the programs or sub-programs indicated herein. Accordingly, the NNA shall prepare a work and financial plan covering the projects or activities to be funded from prior years' subsidies subject to the endorsement of the NNA's Board of Directors, to be submitted to the DDM for approval.
- 3. Special Provisions Applicable to All Government Corporations. In addition to the foregoing special provisions, the special provisions applicable to all government corporations enumerated under the Budgetary Support to Government Corporations-Others shall be observed by the NHA.
