**Special Provision(s)**

1. **Provision of Topographic Maps.** The amount of Three Hundred Twenty Eight Million Thirty Five Thousand Pesos (P328,035,000) appropriated herein shall be used for the production of topographic maps. The topographic maps and permutations thereof generated by the National Mapping and Resource Information Authority (NAMRIA) shall be made readily available at no cost to national government agencies, for use in the performance of the latter's respective mandates.

2. **Rice Subsidy.** The amount of One Million Nine Hundred Fifty Thousand Pesos (P1,950,000) appropriated herein shall be used for the provision of rice subsidy, equivalent to twenty (20) kilos of rice a month, in the form of financial assistance to the uniformed personnel of NAMRIA.

3. **Subsistence Allowance.** The amount of Twenty Four Million Eight Hundred Two Thousand Pesos (P24,802,000) appropriated herein shall be used for the provision of subsistence allowance for uniformed personnel, equivalent to Three Hundred Fifty Pesos (P350) per day effective 01 January 2026.

Implementation of this provision shall be subject to the guidelines to be issued consistent with E.O. No. 107, s. 2025.

4. **Reporting and Posting Requirements.** The NAMRIA shall submit quarterly reports on its financial and physical accomplishments, within thirty (30) days after the end of every quarter, through the following:

(a) URS or other electronic means for reports not covered by the URS until such time that all agencies have fully migrated to the BTMS; and

(b) NAMRIA's website.

The NAMRIA shall send written notice when said reports have been submitted or posted on its website to the DBM, House of Representatives, Senate of the

Philippines, House Committee on Appropriations, Senate Committee on Finance, and other offices where the submission of reports is required under existing laws, rules, and regulations. The date of notice to said agencies shall be considered the date of compliance with this requirement.

4. **Appropriations for Activities or Projects.** The amounts appropriated herein shall be used specifically for the following activities or projects in the indicated amounts and conditions:
