

LOCAL BUDGET CIRCULAR

SUBJECT

Revised Rates of Representation and Transportation Allowances

(RATA)

1.0 Purpose

This Circular is issued to implement the revised RATA rates authorized under Section 44, General Provisions of RA No. 9524, the FY 2009 General Appropriations Act (GAA), for local government officials and employees and to prescribe the funding source therefor.

2.0 RATA Rates

- 2.1 The following officials and employees of provincial, city and municipal governments are equated to national government officials and employees entitled to RATA under the GAA, as shown in Annex "A."
 - a. Local Chief Executive
 - b. Local Vice Chief Executive
 - c. Sanggunian Members
 - d. Department Heads
 - e. Assistant Department Heads
 - f. Chiefs of Hospital
 - g. Division Chiefs in Special Cities
- 2.2 The revised RATA rates for the aforecited officials and employees are as indicated in Annex "B." Such RATA rates are percentages of the RATA rates for equivalent national government officials, and are dependent on the income classification of local government units, consistent with the last paragraph of said Section 44.
- 2.3 Payment of the RATA shall be subject to the pertinent rules and regulations under Local Budget Circular No. 79 dated April 1, 2005.

3.0 Limitation on Personal Services Expenditure

The grant of RATA at the revised rates is subject to the 45%/55% limit on personal services expenditures mandated under Section 325(a), RA No. 7160, "Local Government Code of 1991."

4.0 Funding Sources

The funds for the purpose shall be charged against the respective local government funds.

5.0 Effectivity

This Circular shall take effect April 2009.
