Subject : BUDGET PRIORITIES FRAMEWORK FOR THE PREPARATION OF THE FY 2022 AGENCY BUDGET PROPOSALS UNDER TIER 2

1.0 PURPOSE

For

This FY 2022 National Budget Memorandum (NBM) aims to provide departments and agencies with the following:

- 1.1 Information on the very limited FY 2022 fiscal space available for Tier 2 given the adverse effect of the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) on economic activity and the revenue collections of the government since last year;
- 1.2 As a result, the selection of programs/projects to be prioritized for funding under the said fiscal space under Tier 2 has to be strategic and will yield the maximum results desired; and
- 1.3 Updated Tier 1 levels of departments/agencies which are still subject to changes/modifications (Annex A).

The final macroeconomic assumptions and fiscal aggregates for the FY 2022 Budget which were approved by the Development Budget Coordination Committee (DBCC) on May 18, 2021, as well as the information on the resulting fiscal space, shall be issued separately.

2.0 EXPENDITURE DIRECTIONS FOR FY 2022

In light of the continued COVID-19 recovery efforts and the meager fiscal space, the following strategic programs shall be prioritized for Tier 2 funding:

2.1 Vaccination Program (Booster Shots)

The vaccine statistics¹ show that to date, the Philippines has close to 3,000 vaccination sites conducting COVID-19 vaccination across all regions. With the continuing arrival of additional doses, some 2,801,020 (92.6 percent) doses of the available vaccines have been distributed to the different regions. From these distributed doses, almost

1.3 million doses were administered to healthcare workers, senior citizens, and persons with comorbidities. The target is to vaccinate around 50-70 million adults this year.

Accordingly, the government will continue to provide support for the procurement and distribution of the vaccines and booster shots that could prevent further COVID-19 infection. According to the Vaccine Expert Panel (VEP), which is under the Department of Science and Technology (DOST), there is a need for booster shots to strengthen the immunity of those who already received the COVID-19 vaccine to prevent the adverse symptoms of the disease. This will provide added protection against the other variants of the virus to keep the public safe.

2.2 NG Assistance to Disadvantaged Local Government Units (LGUs)

2.2.1 Growth Equity Fund

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In order to address the issues of unequal development, high poverty incidence and disparities in the fiscal capacities among LGUs, a Growth Equity Fund (GEF) is being proposed to provide assistance to LGUs with the highest poverty incidence, and are financially challenged to level the playing field in the implementation of devolved services.

The GEF aims to cover the funding and capacity development requirements of basic infrastructure and other programs, projects and activities of poor, disadvantaged and lagging LGUs to gradually enable them to implement the functions and services devolved to LGUs by pertinent laws more effectively and efficiently. The Fund is time-bound and performance based, and shall be provided to LGUs for a fixed time frame.

Thus, it should be noted that **proposals for new and expanded local projects** of NGAs associated with these devolved services will no longer be accommodated under the Tier 2 budget for FY 2022. The GEF shall serve as the main NG support to the extremely poor and disadvantaged LGUs.

2.2.2 Capacity Development for LGUs

Consistent with the thrust to empower LGUs to fulfill their mandates under the Local Government Code as well as to provide quality services to their constituents, the NG shall fully support the provision of capacity development programs to LGUs. Funding requirements for their training and capacity building needs associated with the implementation of the Supreme Court Ruling on the Mandanas-Garcia Cases shall be lodged under the Department of the Interior and Local Government – Local Government Academy which shall oversee the provision of needed capacity development interventions to the LGUs.

2.3 Establishment of the Virology Science and Technology Institute of the Philippines

There will be a greater necessity to exploit advances in biology and medical science in the Post-Pandemic Normal. Hence, investments in the field of health research & development (R&D) will need to be prioritized towards enhanced capacity for knowledge and technology generation, acquisition and adoption. The Virology Science and Technology Institute of the Philippines (VIP) is envisioned to be the country's premier research institute on virology of humans, animals, and plants. It will provide: (1) the necessary diagnostics for the effective management of virus transmission, (2) research advancing vaccine production, (3) treatment by local manufacturers, and (4)

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understanding of the behavioral and social impact of virus outbreaks. The Institute shall collaborate with the international scientific community to advance local virology knowledge and scientific social capital.

The assembly of Filipino researchers possessing competence in virology on humans, animals, and plants, which is the first of the two-phased plan of the VIP, can be supported through the Balik Scientist Program along with Department of Science and Technology's (DOST) strategic international collaboration with scientists, virology centers, and institutes. The tapping of Filipino virologists who have undergone training from foreign institutions will play a significant role in the planned establishment of VIP as their expertise could be utilized to meet the human resource requirements of the VIP in their development and implementation of research programs and projects in the country.

An enabling environment must also be prepared and strengthened in anticipation of the second-phase of the VIP on its establishment of a research facility. This entails the formulation of guidelines to resolve regulatory and implementation bottlenecks among others, for the specialized facilities and equipment, as well as the inventory of available resources that may be shared and utilized for mass production.

2.4 Family Planning

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With more than 110 million Filipinos, the country's increasing population has highlighted the risks and vulnerability of the people especially those in highly urbanized areas and in large families during the time of the COVID-19 pandemic. The high level of population density in urban areas also contributed to the spread of the virus infection due to the difficulty to enforce minimum health protocols.

To respond to this concern, the government shall adopt an intensified implementation of the Family Planning Program based on the Presidential directive aimed to curb rapid population growth through (i) the promotion and provision of modern family planning methods, (ii) encouraging smaller family sizes, and (iii) implementing policies that will reduce the population momentum (e.g., promote later age at marriage, delay childbearing and further space births). The need to intensify the level of awareness and knowledge on the importance and benefits of family planning is crucial since it can impact poverty reduction as it enables couples to properly plan and invest in their children. Consequently, this will help the country sustain the demographic dividend during which the working-age population in the economy is young, healthy, educated, and has the appropriate skills set to be productive.

2.5 Nutrition

Based on the 2019 Expanded National Nutrition Survey, malnutrition is prevalent among Filipino children. The 2019 survey showed alarming results, wherein 28.8 percent of the country's children under 5 years are stunted, 19.0 percent are underweight, and 5.8 percent are wasted.² Childhood stunting has been associated with lower learning outcomes, poor academic performance, and consequently, lower productivity and wages in adulthood. In addition, the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic has added risks to the nutritional status and survival of children.

The Inter-Agency Task Force on Zero Hunger created through Executive Order No. 11 s., 2020 was mandated to formulate the National Food Policy (NFP) which outlines the national priorities and roadmap for achieving zero hunger. The NFP also includes

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initiatives for ending hunger, achieving food security, improving nutrition, and promoting sustainable agriculture.

To further support the country's nutrition crisis, the government shall adopt a multisectoral approach which will address the causes of childhood malnutrition by providing nutrition-specific and nutrition-sensitive interventions especially in provinces and municipalities with the highest stunting rates. The said approach aims to strengthen the delivery of nutrition and primary health services as well as the nutrition convergence efforts at the community level. This will be undertaken through collaborative efforts by the national and local governments as well as the community organizations to ensure the program's sustainability.

2.6 National Identification System and Interagency Integration

The difficulties experienced in the targeting and contact-tracing of beneficiaries in the delivery of goods and services during the COVID-19 pandemic, have highlighted the significance of a national identification system. Hence, the implementation of the Philippine Identification System (PhilSys) shall be fast-tracked, involving the completion of registration guidelines and protocols; recruitment and training of field registration personnel; and establishment of registration centers.

Interoperability across government agencies shall also be pursued by revisiting existing systems and databases to ensure that the PhilSys numbers will be utilized in generating and processing data information. The resulting integrated system shall serve as a basic reference in the government's efforts both in terms of assisting priority groups and towards a more efficient and inclusive provision of key services such as pension, conditional cash transfer, farmer assistance, health coverage, among others.

2.7 Other Priority Expenditures

Given the absence of fiscal space, NGAs shall accommodate their proposals for new or expanded programs and projects within their Tier 1 allocations. These new and expanded programs shall be limited to those in the updated Philippine Development Plan (PDP), and the Three (3)-Year Rolling Infrastructure Program (TRIP).
