UPDATING OF THE CONVERGENCE PROGRAMS AND

PROJECTS AND NOMINATION OF PROGRAM CONVERGENCE BUDGETING (PCB) FOCAL PERSONS FOR THE ONLINE SUBMISSION OF THE BUDGET PREPARATION (BP) FORM 206

(FORMERLY BP FORM 202-A) AND BP FORM 708

1.0 BACKGROUND

- 1.1 The Program Convergence Budgeting is an approach that aims to focus government resources on key programs and projects which shall be coordinated in a holistic approach across Departments/ Agencies working towards the same goals.
- 1.2 Consistent with the commitment of institutionalizing the PCB strategy in the budget process, this Memorandum is being issued to facilitate the validation/ updating of the Matrix of Priority Programs and Participating Agencies attached to the instructions in accomplishing BP Form 206 and BP Form 708 as prescribed in the annual National and Corporate Budget Call, respectively. Likewise, Heads of PCB Lead and Participating Agencies/ GOCCs are enjoined to nominate their respective PCB Focal Persons.
- 1.3 As part of its thrust for bureaucratic efficiency and transparency through the digitalization of government processes, the submission of the BP Form 206 and BP 708 through the Online Submission of Budget Proposal System (OSBPS) shall be required starting with the submission of PCB proposals for the FY 2024 Budget.

2.0 PURPOSE

- 2.1 To shift the mode of submission of BP Form 206 and BP Form 708 from manual to online.
- 2.2 To clarify the roles of PCB lead and participating agencies and to identify PCB Focal Persons for purposes of accomplishing BP Form 206 and BP Form 708.

3.0 VALIDATION/ UPDATING OF THE MATRIX OF PRIORITY PROGRAMS AND PARTICIPATING AGENCIES

- 3.1 PCB Lead Agencies as identified in Annex A of this National Budget Memorandum (NBM) shall validate/ update the following:
 - 3.1.1 PCB Program and Project Titles under their respective coverage; and
 - 3.1.2 List of participating agencies/ GOCCs for their respective PCB Programs and Projects.

4.0 ROLES OF LEAD AND PARTICIPATING AGENCIES

- 4.1 Participating Agencies shall submit to the PCB Lead Agency the targets and funding requirements corresponding to its contribution to the attainment of the targets of a PCB Program, for the latter's information and evaluation. Participating Agencies shall only include in BP Form 206 and BP Form 708 component programs/ projects, targets, and funding requirements that have been coordinated with PCB Lead Agencies.
- 4.2 PCB Lead Agencies in turn shall ensure that the contributions of participating agencies to PCB programs are reasonable, appropriate and supportive of the attainment of the goals and objectives of the PCB Program.
- 4.3 Both Participating and Lead Agencies shall ensure that the preparation of PCB proposals are done in a coordinated and holistic manner. It must be emphasized that the hard copy submission must be the same as the encoded data under the OSBPS v2.0. In the event of inconsistency, the encoded data shall prevail and will be regarded as the official submission of the Departments/Agencies.

5.0 IDENTIFICATION OF PCB FOCAL PERSONS

- 5.1 Agencies that have PCB Programs and Projects are enjoined to nominate one (1) PCB Focal Person. Said Focal Person shall register as a user in the OSBPS through this link: https://apps.dbm.gov.ph/signup.
- 5.2 PCB Lead and Participating Agencies shall submit the following information of their PCB Focal Person to the PCB Lead Agency for consolidation:
 - 5.2.1 Full Name;
 - 5.2.2 Email Address;
 - 5.2.3 Department/Agency;
 - 5.2.4 Operating Unit, if applicable;
 - 5.2.5 Role (Lead or Participating).
- 5.3 PCB Lead Agencies shall submit to the DBM the **consolidated list of PCB Focal Persons** under their respective coverages.

5.4 The DBM shall validate the PCB Focal Person Registrants against the consolidated list submitted by the PCB Lead Agencies. Only the PCB Focal Persons of participating agencies/ GOCCs included in the consolidated list submitted by the PCB Lead Agency will be given access in the OSBPS to encode/ edit BP 206 or BP Form 708, as applicable.

6.0 DEADLINE OF SUBMISSIONS

- 6.1 PCB Lead Agencies shall submit their validated Matrix of Priority Programs and Projects and consolidated list of nominated PCB Focal Persons to the DBM on or before January 20, 2023.
- 6.3 The Matrix of Priority Programs and Projects and consolidated list of PCB Focal Persons shall be officially submitted to the DBM both in printed and electronic forms thru the DBM Central Records Division and dbm.gov.ph, respectively.
