### Legal Basis

- **Executive Order No. 122-A** (January 30, 1987) created the Office on Muslim Affairs (OMA) to ensure the rights and well-being of Muslim Filipinos.
- **Executive Order No. 295** (July 25, 1987), amending EO 122-A, created the Bureau of Pilgrimage and Endowment (from the abolished Philippine Pilgrimage Authority), placing it under OMA.

### Mandate

The Office on Muslim Affairs (OMA) preserves and develops the culture, traditions, institutions, and well-being of Muslim Filipinos in conformity with the country's laws and in consonance with national unity and development.
