
Legal Basis

- **Republic Act No. 7611** (June 19, 1992), the Strategic Environmental Plan (SEP) for Palawan Act, provided for the adoption of a comprehensive framework for the sustainable development of Palawan, compatible with protecting and enhancing the natural resources and endangered environment of the province. It created the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD) to be responsible for the governance and implementation of, and provision of policy direction to, the SEP. It converted the Palawan Integrated Area Development Project Office (PIADPO) to the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development to the Council.
- Executive Order No. 734 (June 18, 2008), transferring the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD) from the Office of the President to the Department of Environment and Natural Resources.

Mandate

The Palawan Council for Sustainable Development Staff (PCSDS) serves as the regular staff of the Palawan Council for Sustainable Development (PCSD) in the coordination of policies and functions, implementation of programs, and organization of services for the governance and implementation of, and formulation of policy directions for, the Strategic Environmental Plan for Palawan.
