

## PRESIDENTIAL MANAGEMENT STAFF


### **Legal Basis**

- Executive Order No. 250 (July 29, 1970) created the Development Management Staff (DMS) within the Office of the President.
- **Presidential Decree No. 955** (July 8, 1976) reconstituted and renamed DMS as the Presidential Management Staff (PMS).
- Executive Order No. 130 (January 30, 1987) reorganized PMS, defined its powers and functions, and merged and consolidated all offices and agencies whose functions overlap and/or are interrelated within the reorganized PMS.

#### Mandate

The Presidential Management Staff (PMS) provides staff assistance to the Office of the President in the Presidential exercise of overall management of the development process. Over the years, it has assumed additional mandates evolving according to the day-to-day and long-term needs of the Presidency.
