
Legal Basis

- **Republic Act No. 6425** (November 14, 1972), "Dangerous Drugs Act of 1972", organized the Dangerous Drugs Board (DDB).
- **Republic Act No. 9165** (June 7, 2002), "Comprehensive Dangerous Drugs Act of 2002", repealed the Dangerous Drugs Act of 1972 (RA 6425), creating the Philippine Drug Enforcement Agency (PDEA) as the implementing arm of the DDB.

Mandate

The Dangerous Drugs Board (DDB) plans and formulates policies and programs on drug prevention and control. It develops and adopts a comprehensive, integrated, unified, and balanced national drug abuse prevention and control strategy.




