
Legal Basis

- **Public Act No. 451** (October 23, 1933) created the Philippine Historical Research and Markers Committee (PHRMC) to mark historical antiquities in Manila and later throughout the archipelago.
- Executive Order No. 91 (January 23, 1937) replaced the PHRMC with the Philippine Historical Committee (PHC).
- Executive Order No 52 (August 10, 1954) created the Jose Rizal National Centennial Commission (JRNCC), co-existing with the PHC in undertaking cultural activities.
- Executive Order No. 28 (October 3, 1963) created the National Heroes Commission, replacing the JRNCC.
- Republic Act No. 4368 (June 19, 1965) created the National Historical Commission taking over the functions of the National Heroes Commission as an agency attached to the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS).
- **Presidential Decree No. 1** (September 24, 1972) reorganized the National Historical Commission as the National Historical Institute.

Mandate

The National Historical Institute (NHI) undertakes research and publication of Philippine historical works and educational activities on historical events and personages; restoration, preservation and conservation of movable and immovable objects of historical value; and implementation of the National Historic Act of the Philippines (PD 260 and PD 1505); administration of historic sites, structures and memorabilia of national heroes; and implementation of Republic Act 8491 or "The Flag and Heraldic Code of the Philippines."


