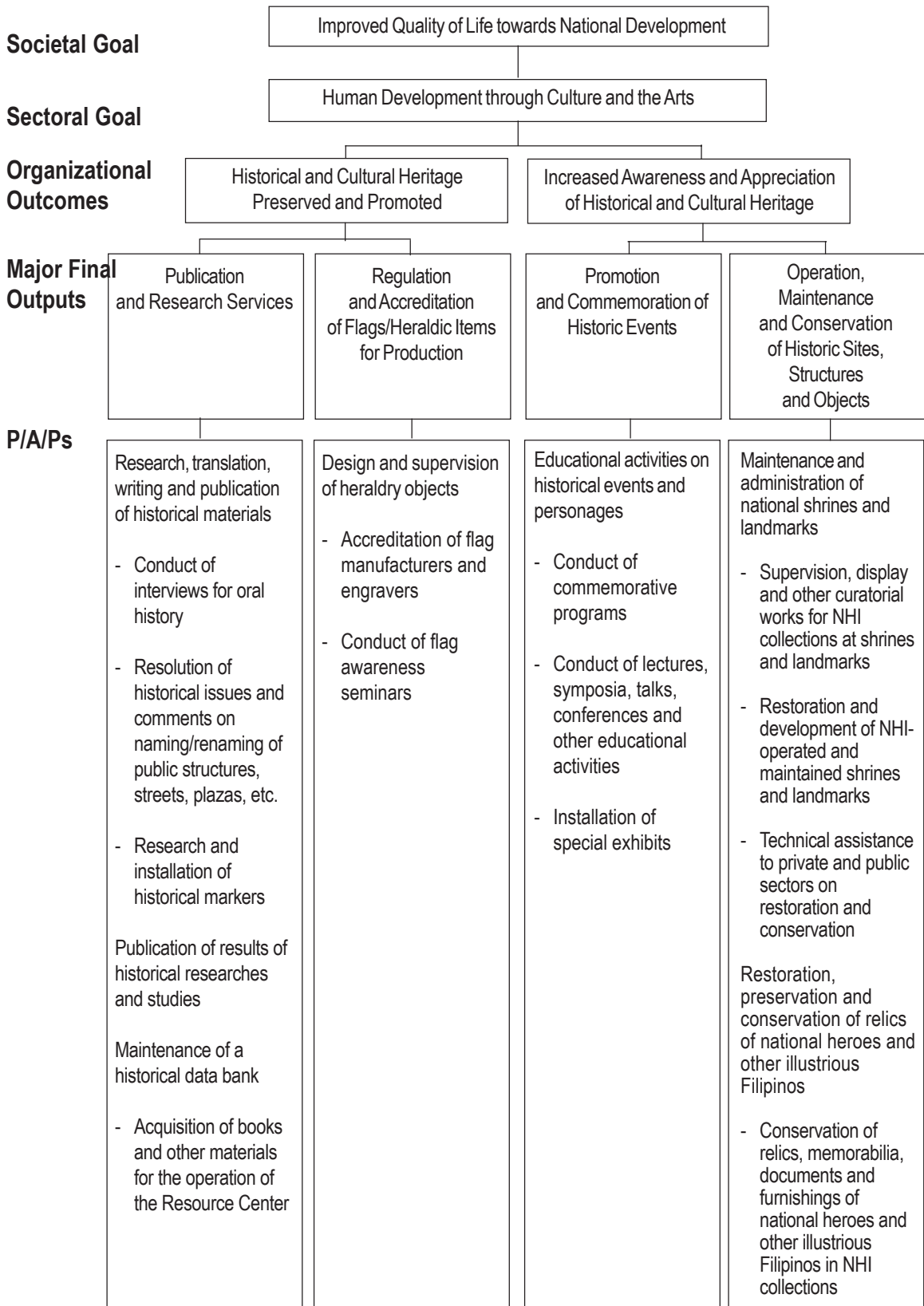
### Legal Basis

- **Public Act No. 451** (October 23, 1933) created the Philippine Historical Research and Markers Committee (PHRMC) to mark historical antiquities in Manila and later throughout the archipelago.
- **Executive Order No. 91** (January 23, 1937) replaced the PHRMC with the Philippine Historical Committee (PHC).
- **Executive Order No 52** (August 10, 1954) created the Jose Rizal National Centennial Commission (JRNCC), co-existing with the PHC in undertaking cultural activities.
- **Executive Order No. 28** (October 3, 1963) created the National Heroes Commission, replacing the JRNCC.
- **Republic Act No. 4368** (June 19, 1965) created the National Historical Commission taking over the functions of the National Heroes Commission as an agency attached to the Department of Education, Culture and Sports (DECS).
- **Presidential Decree No. 1** (September 24, 1972) reorganized the National Historical Commission as the National Historical Institute.

### Mandate

The National Historical Institute (NHI) undertakes research and publication of Philippine historical works and educational activities on historical events and personages; restoration, preservation and conservation of movable and immovable objects of historical value; and implementation of the National Historic Act of the Philippines (PD 260 and PD 1505); administration of historic sites, structures and memorabilia of national heroes; and implementation of Republic Act 8491 or “The Flag and Heraldic Code of the Philippines.”

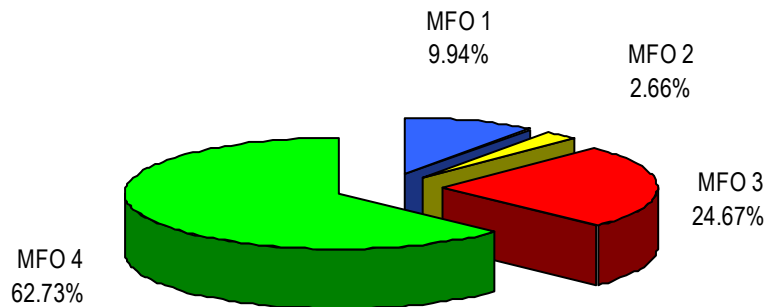
