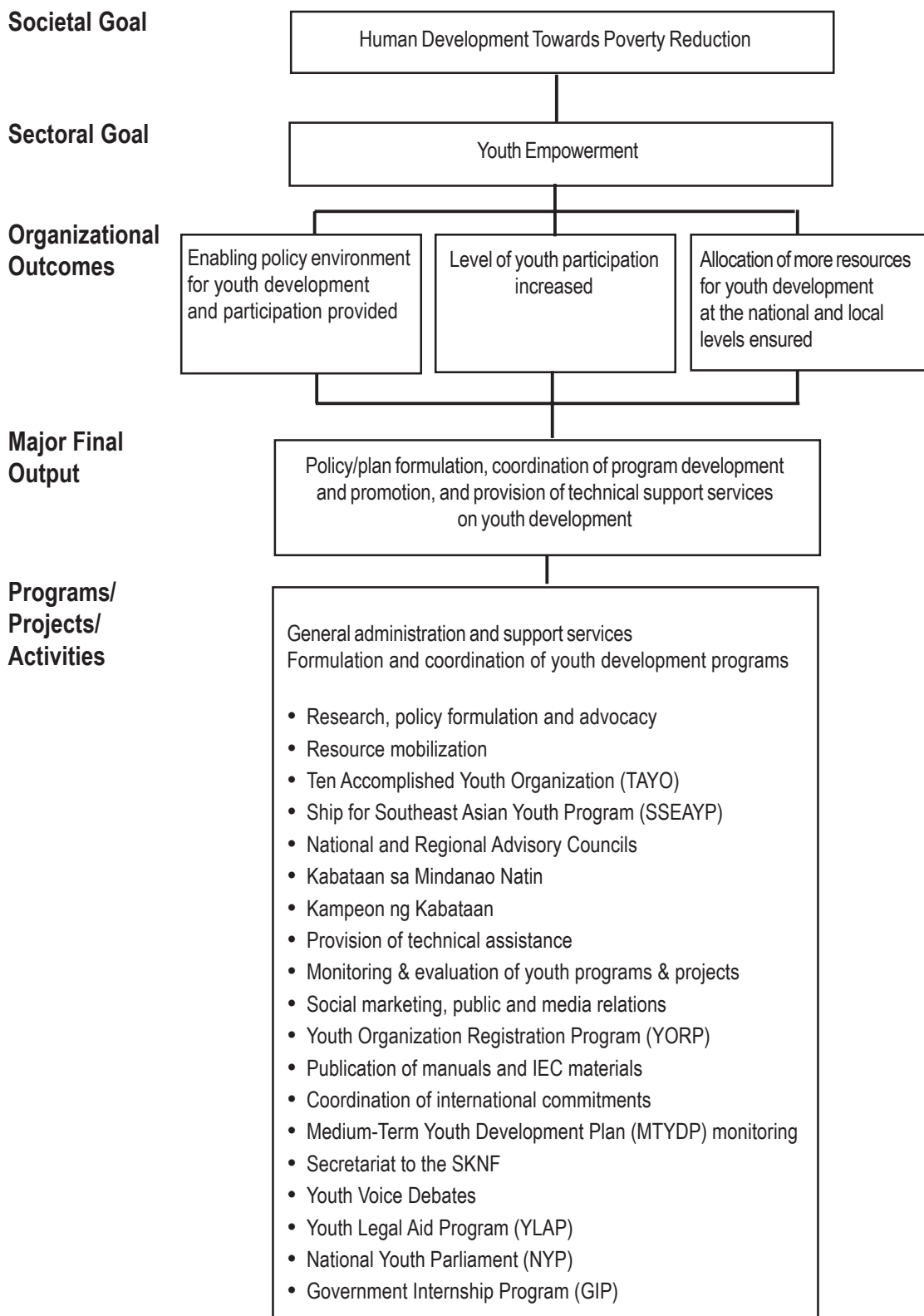
Legal Basis

- **Republic Act No. 8044** (June 7, 1995), “Youth in Nation Building Act”, created the National Youth Commission (NYC) to be the policy-making and coordinating body of all youth-related institutions, programs, projects and activities of the government.
- **Executive Order No. 438** (June 27, 2005) provided for the NYC to monitor the implementation of the Medium-Term Youth Development Plan (MTYDP) 2005-2010 in coordination with concerned agencies.

Mandate

The National Youth Commission (NYC) is responsible for policy formulation on, and review of, youth promotion and development programs, establishment of a consultative mechanism for dialogue with the youth, and linking with government and non-government organizations both at the national and international levels for the youth’s active participation in government and non-government programs that will develop their full potential as partners in nation building.
