

Commission on Appointments


Legal Basis

The Philippine Constitution of 1987 (Sec. 18, Article VI) created a Commission on Appointments composed of the President of the Senate, as ex-officio Chairman, and an equal number of Senators and Members of the House of Representatives (12 each), elected by each House on the basis of proportional representation from the political parties and parties or organizations registered under the party-list system represented in Congress.

Mandate

The Commission on Appointments (CA) acts on all appointments submitted to it within 30 session days of Congress from the submission of said appointments. The CA, cognizant of the consideration given by the Appointing Authority to the exercise of the power of appointment, accords due weight and respect to the appointment to the end that doubts relative to it are resolved in favor of approval or confirmation. It acts as a restraint against abuse of the Appointing Authority to the end that the power of disapproval is exercised to protect and enhance the public interest. The CA discharges its constitutional duties towards the efficent and harmonious functioning of government.


