Legal Basis

- **Executive Order No. 192** (June 10, 1987) created the Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB) as a staff bureau of the reorganized Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) (from the Department of Environment, Energy and Natural Resources) by absorbing the Bureau of Mines and Geo-Sciences (BMGS), Mineral Reservations Development Board (MRDB), and the Gold Mining Industry Development Board (GMIDB).
- **Republic Act No. 7942** (March 3, 1995), otherwise known as the Philippine Mining Act of 1995, defined the line functions of the MGB under the DENR, and provided for the creation of the Bureau's Regional Offices.

Mandate

The Mines and Geosciences Bureau (MGB) is responsible for the administration and disposition of mineral lands and mineral resources and the conduct of geological, mining, metallurgical, chemical and other researches, as well as geological and mineral exploration surveys. It implements the DENR's mandate in relation to the conservation, management, development and proper use of the State's mineral resources, including those in reservations, watershed areas, and lands of the public domain.

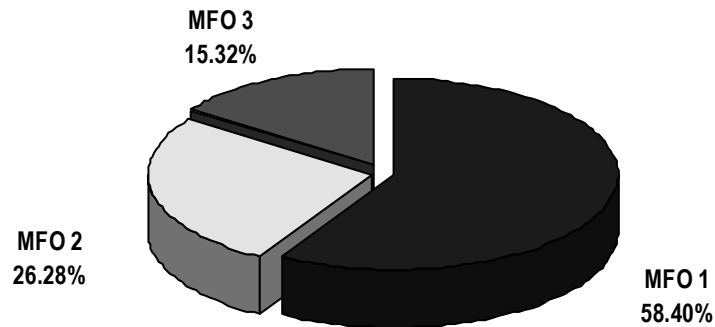
