
Legal Basis

- The 1987 Constitution of the Philippines (Section 5, Article XI,) created an independent Office of the Ombudsman.
- Executive Order No. 243 and No. 244 (July 24, 1987) decreed the formal organization of the Office of the Ombudsman and transformed the former Tanodbayan into the Office of the Special Prosecutor as its organic part.
- Republic Act No. 6770 (November 17, 1989), otherwise known as "The Ombudsman Act of 1989", provided for the functional and structural organization of the Office of the Ombudsman.

Mandate

The Office of the Ombudsman protects the people from illegal, unjust, improper or inefficient act of any public official, employee, office or agency. It shall act promptly on complaints filed in any form or manner against officials and employees of the Government, or any of its subdivision, or instrumentalities, including government-owned or controlled corporations. It enforces administrative, civil or criminal liability where the evidence warrants to promote efficient government service.
